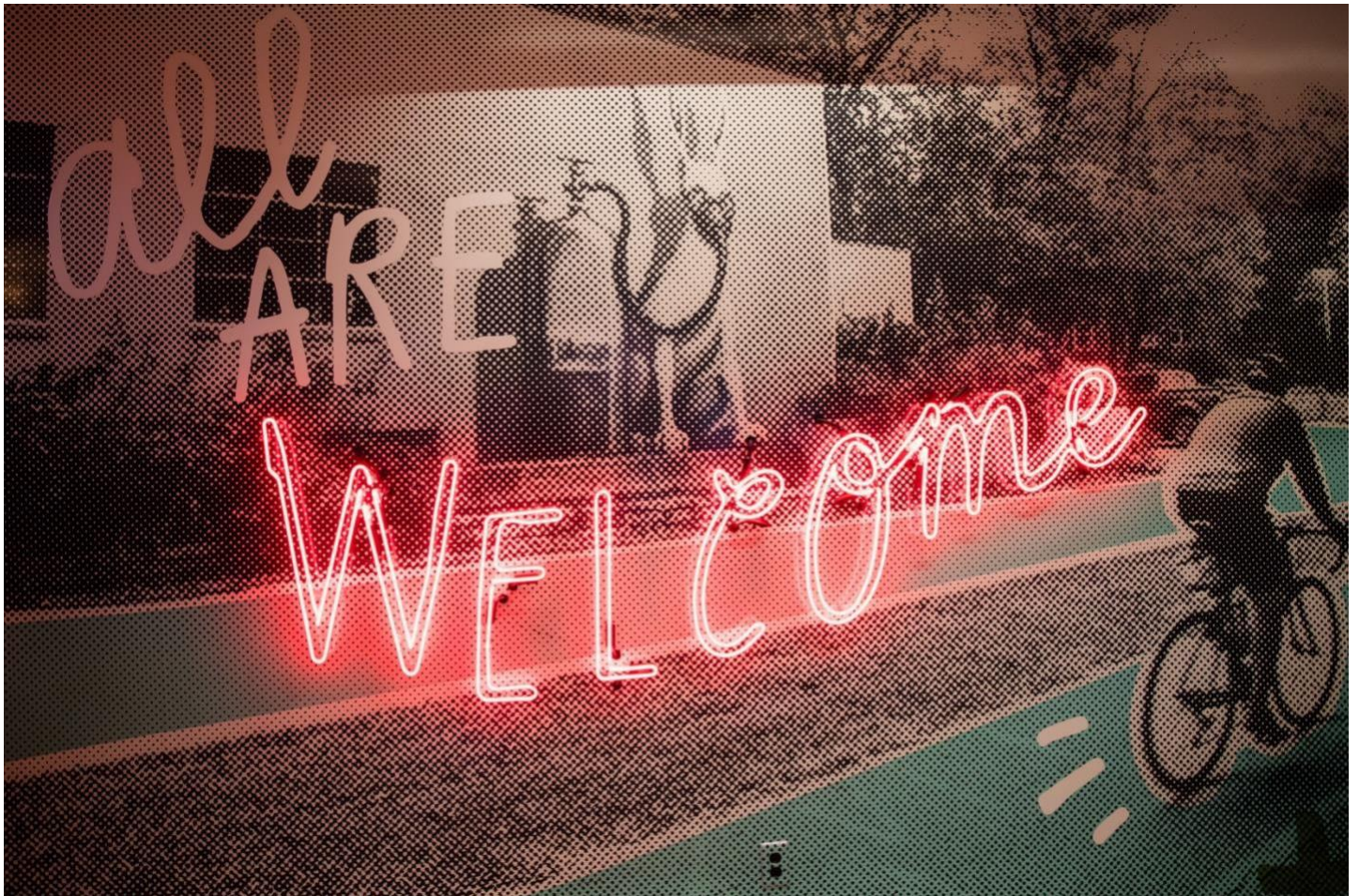


1. Welcome

- Sent by post-mail, following the completion of Fayetteville World Cup and validation of official results
- Form nr W-9 must be filled up
- Forms can be filled out during Rider Registration or sent to below email no later than 1 NOV

BEL / NED: via the National Federation

- Form nr W-8 EN **must** be filled up
- Forms can be filled out during Rider Registration or sent to below email no later than 1 NOV
- Payment via the National Federation

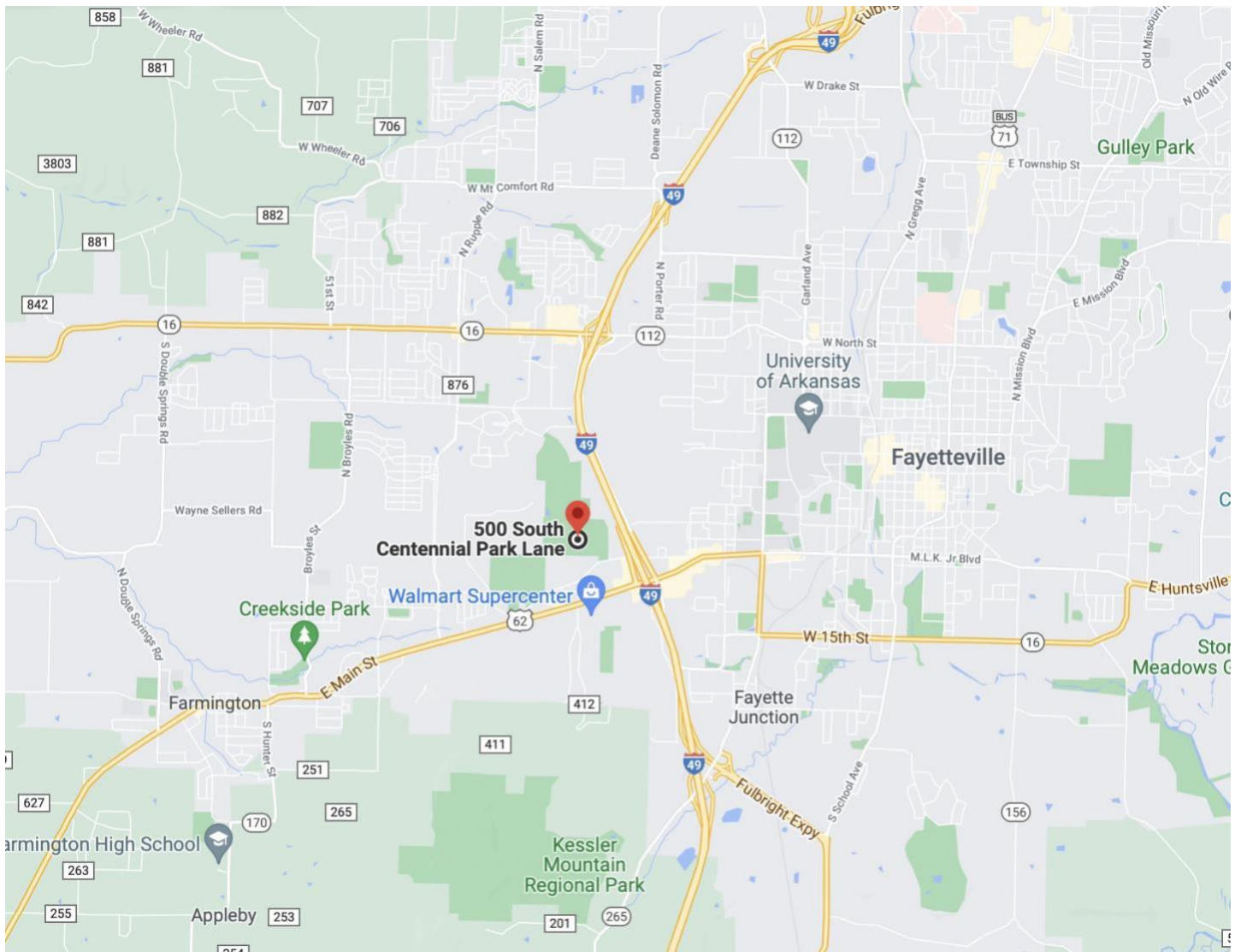

7. Rider Confirmation

Rider confirmation will take place on 15 OCT @ 17h15 at the race venue in the Commissaire tent (please see map under Race HQ). The rider will receive an envelope with 1 back number, 1 transponder, 2 shoulder numbers.

There is NO wristband or accreditation needed for Athletes or Team staff to enter venue. All teams will receive parking passes for team vehicles per parking instructions under Team Parking.

The national coaches or Team Managers of the UCI cyclo-cross teams receive a "pit" and "start/finish" wristband depending on the number of riders they represent (see UCI Communique for the exact number per team - national team).

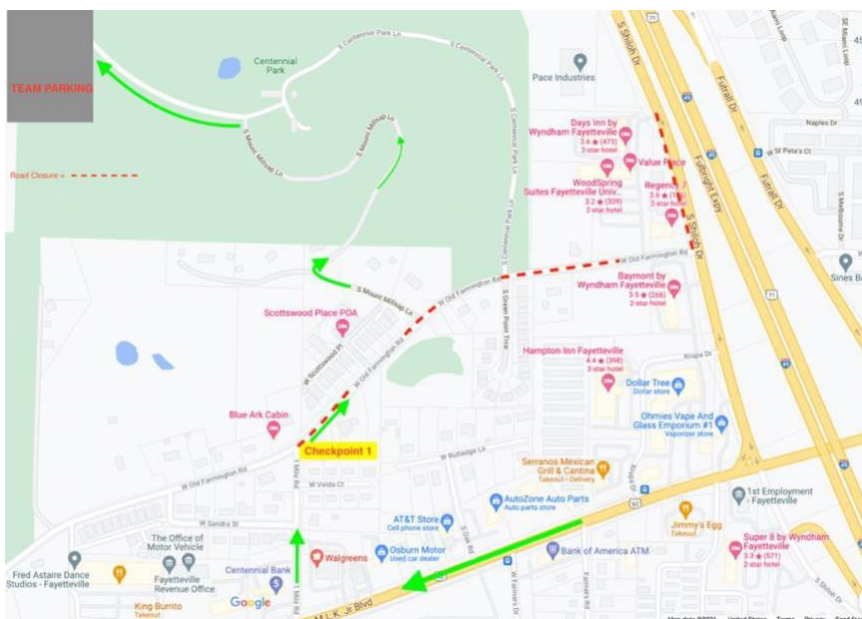

Any Camper/RV over 30ft/9.1m will need to enter venue by 08h00 on both 15 & 16 OCT

Once at Checkpoint 1, you will receive your parking passes and directed into venue. Parking assignments will be given to you upon arrival at Team Parking



9. Circuit

Full lap: 1.8 miles, 2.89km

Distance from Start to Pit 1 - .84 miles, 1.35 km

Pit 1 to Pit 2: .66 miles, 1.06km

Distance from Pit 2 to Finish: .26 miles, .41km

Pit 2 - Pit 1: 1.1 miles, 1.77 km

Description

3% Pavement/97% Grass. The course will have a double pit. Three course features include (2) flyovers, one (1) set of stairs and a section of stone cobbles.

Warm-Up Periods

Helmets must be worn AT ALL TIMES when riding the course - failure to comply may result in disqualification.

UCI Cyclo-cross World Cup Races Official Training Periods

- Saturday, October 15, 12h00 – 13h30
- Sunday, October 16, 8h40 - 9h10, 11h00 – 12h00, and 13h15 – 13h45

No other racers or staff are permitted on the course during the UCI Cyclo-cross World Cup Official Training Periods. This rule will be strictly enforced.
