PROGRAMME

On Sunday 5 June, the Brussels-Capital Region takes centre stage. Fans from the first hour can enjoy the start in the beautiful JubelPark, right in the centre of the country's capital city. The finish, as usual, is in the shadow of the Atomium and the King Baudouin Stadium. Discover the programme and the mobility information to make your Whit Sunday a great day of racing in the city!

What's on the programme?

11 A.M.: Start presentation in the JubelPark

12:15 P.M.: Start in the JubelPark

5:09 P.M.: Earliest foreseen finish on the Houba de Strooperlaan

Unfortunately, Covid-19 is still around. This means the team zone at both the start and the finish will not be accessible to the public. However, you can be in the front row when the starting signal sounds and when the winner throws his arms up in the air.



HOW DO I GET TO THERE?**On foot**

- ▶ The **START** of the Brussels Cycling Classic is in the Jubelpark in Brussels and the start is of course easily accessible on foot from the city centre.
- ▶ You can see the riders **FINISH** on the Houba de Strooperlaan in Brussels. Do you live nearby? If so, it's best to come on foot to the public zone at the finish.

By bike

- ▶ Will you be coming to the Brussels Cycling Classic by bike? Then you can leave your bike in one of the secure parking spots in the vicinity of the Jubelpark or the Houba de Strooperlaan. More information about the availability and the prices can be found [here](#). For safety's sake, always bring your own lock!

By train

- ▶ Brussel-Centraal is a 25-minute walk from the **START**.
- ▶ Would you like to cheer on your favourite rider to victory? Then it's best to take the train to Jette. The station is a 20-minute walk from the **FINISH** at Houba de Strooperlaan.
- ▶ Be sure to check the [train timetable](#) so you can get there without problems.

By metro

- ▶ Lines 1 and 5 bring you to the **START** at the Jubelpark. These lines run between the eastern and western parts of the city. The Schuman and Montgomery stops are within walking distance of the park.
- ▶ Line 6 brings you to the **FINISH** at Houba De Strooperlaan. The stops Roi Baudouin and Houba-Brugmann are both within walking distance of the finish.
- ▶ All information and timetables can be found [here](#).

By bus

- ▶ The Etterbeek Général Leman, Bruxelles Nerviens, Bruxelles Froissart and Bruxelles Parc Léopold stops are all within walking distance of the **START** at the Jubelpark.
- ▶ The stops at Brussel Stadion and Brussel Brugmann are both within walking distance of the **FINISH**.

RACE INFORMATION

The countdown to the next race has begun. What you still need from us, naturally, is the course information. Below you can find all the information to help you enjoy the race on 5 June.

DE MUUR AGAIN

The route of the Brussels Cycling Classic has changed a bit since last year and thus a little refreshment will not hurt. After the start in the Jubelpark, the peloton heads to Tervuren, where the official start signal for the race of 203.9 km will be sounded. After nearly 50 km of racing, the riders are faced with the Rue du Croiseau, the first of a total of 10 climbs.

With a little less than 90 km to go, it's time for the first passage in Geraardsbergen and thus the Muur-Bosberg duo followed by the Congoberg on Galmaarden soil. That trio is then tackled for a second time before the peloton heads for Brussels. Two cobblestoned sections and the Heilige kruisewegstraat in Schepdaal, *Evenepoel's hometown*, await in the full finale.

Read on and choose your favourite spot along the course or discover at what time the riders will be passing in front of your house!


