## DUBAI MIRACLE GARDEN

Each season, as the weather begins to cool at the onset of winter, the gates reopen at Dubai Miracle Garden. With more than 150 million flowers in full bloom, this 72,000-sq-m paradise has flowered into one of the region's most picturesque, sweet-scented destinations since it first opened nearly nine years ago.

## JUMEIRAH VILLAGE CIRCLE

Comprised of more than 2,000 spacious villas and townhouses and an exceptional array of amenities and services, it offers residents everything needed to live life to the full. Jumeirah Village Circle provides a beautiful, self-contained environment for residents, with all the modern facilities of a city in a tranquil village setting. ## **DUBAI CRICKET STADIUM**

## **MOTOR CITY**

Set within the heart of the desert on the Emirates Road, 9km inland from intersection 4 on Sheikh Zayed Road near the Mall of The Emirates. There is excellent access to Abu Dhabi, Al Ain, and Sharjah from the Emirates Road and only 15 minutes to Dubai Airport. You can bypass all the Dubai traffic and go to Al Khail Road to get anywhere in town i.e. Dubai mall, Jumeirah, or across town to the Creek or Oud Metha on the Business Bay crossing. The Dubai Bypass Road is minutes behind the Ranches and will take you to RAK and Fujairah quickly.

## **GLOBAL VILLAGE**

Global Village in Dubai is located on Sheikh Mohammed Bin Zayed Road E 311 road (United Arab Emirates) Dubai. It combines cultures of 90 countries across the world at one place. It claims to be the world's largest tourism, leisure, shopping and entertainment project. It is the region's first cultural, entertainment, family and shopping destination. Every year, it has over 5 million visitors over an area of 17,200,000 sq ft (1,600,000 m<sup>2</sup>).

## **CITYLAND MALL**

Home to the largest hypermarket in Dubailand, Cityland Mall hosts over 350 brand outlets across six culturally-themed pavilions, 75 dining spots and a cineplex with 10 screens.

Unlike other shopping hotspots in Dubai, this 1.2 million sqft retail and entertainment destination unfolds around an elaborate garden. Located along one of the city's main highways, Sheikh Mohammed Bin Zayed Road, Cityland is also close to popular tourist attractions like Global Village and IMG Worlds of Adventure.

## **SUSTAINABLE CITY**

The Sustainable City contains 500 villas grouped into five residential clusters connected to an urban farm that runs the length of the City. Each cluster is comprised of 90 Courtyard Villas, eight Garden Villas, and two Signature Villas.

The borders of The Sustainable City act as the first line of defense against pollutants. The remarkable 10-metre-high buffer zone running along the periphery of the development consists of 2,500 trees scattered in multiple layers. This purifies the air coming into the city and creates a breeze.

## **AL QUDRA CYCLE TRACK**

Al Qudra Cycling Track is a popular destination among Dubai's adventure seekers and fitness enthusiasts. With 86km of track and amazing views of the desert, you might catch a glimpse of local wildlife – including the Arabian oryx. The track is popular with both professional and novice riders alike and is frequented by both individuals and groups of friends.

The track is also utilised by weekly cycling clubs, world-class athletes, and leisure riders visiting Dubai. Some say that the best time to ride is at sunrise, because the views and feeling of the morning breeze are unparalleled – but the sunsets are just as beautiful. Ensure you plan ahead, as this area has few taxis and much of the track is not illuminated after dark.

## **DUBAI POLO & EQUESTRIAN CLUB**

At the avant-garde Dubai Polo & Equestrian Club, prestigious sporting meets lively social events. Built by polo-pro Ali Albwardy, whose dream was to move chukkas from the sands to vivid greens and spread his passion for the sport – which is exactly what he did with this desert oasis.

Now, the Dubai Polo & Equestrian Club stands as a tribute to the historical game, and is home to the world-renowned Dubai Polo Team. The club also hosts celebrated events like the Cartier International Dubai Polo Challenge, UAE Nations Cup and Sunset Polo International. This fully-equipped equestrian club is also a popular venue for private parties known to attract A-list celebrities.

Equestrian activities are celebrated here as well, ranging from polo to show-jumping and horse-riding. With leisure facilities, restaurants and a magnificent setting, the Dubai Polo & Equestrian Club has certainly earned its respected status within the region's equestrian and leisure society.

## DUBAI EXPO LAKES

Journey into the desert and enjoy the greenery and views of the free-to-visit Lake of Expo 2020. Located near Al Maktoum International Airport, the area has a lake, trees, and sand to resemble the Expo 2020 logo.

A man-made marvel, the site includes walkways to get to the 'island' surrounded by water. A bird's-eye view from the top showcases the logo, so if you're flying in or out from Al Maktoum, look out for this extraordinary spot.

Built by the Dubai Municipality, the lake is free to visit and celebrates the fact that Dubai is hosting the first World Expo in the Middle East, Africa and South Asian region. The first such exhibition hosted by an Arab country, Expo 2020 will welcome 192 countries, plus businesses, multilateral organizations and educational establishments. It takes place from 1 October 2021 to 31 March 2022.

## BAB AL SHAMS

Where Middle Eastern culture meets a radiant love for life, Bab Al Shams is a go-to desert experience just 45 minutes from downtown Dubai or 60 minutes from Dubai International Airport. Inspired by the limitless wonder of the landscape and the stories of its people, our one-of-a-kind resort embraces elegant contemporary rooms and suites within distinctive modernist architecture. Gaze out over captivating desert panoramas or charming courtyard gardens from one of our balconies or scenic private terraces.

Bab Al Shams invites guests to revel in a vibrant celebration of life, where they can indulge in an array of international cuisines and entertainment experiences. To immerse yourself in the soul of Arabia, partake in the theatrical open-air dining experience under the stars at Al Hadheerah. Unwind amidst the desert palms, where tranquil adult and family pools and a serene spa provide endless opportunities for relaxation. Embark on wondrous desert adventures, from soaring high on a hot-air balloon to galloping through the dunes on Arabian horses, embarking on camelback treks, or venturing on nomadic nature tours to Al Marmoom — there is something for every adventurer at Bab Al Shams, from sunrise to sunset.

## AL MARMOOM LOVE LAKE

Immerse yourself in nature when you make your journey to the Al Qudra oasis to take in the sights and sounds of Love Lake Dubai. This popular spot consists two, large, heart-shaped lakes connected to each other.

With plenty of parking, visitors can picnic or set up barbecues in designated areas and take in the serene greenery while keeping an eye out for the wildlife, including many bird species. If you're a fitness

enthusiast, there is also a running track on-site, and Love Lake is very close to the Al Qudra Cycling Track.

## **AL MARMOOM DESERT CONSERVATION RESERVE**

Spanning 10 per cent of Dubai's total area is the Al Marmoom Reserve project, the largest unfenced nature reserve in the UAE. The reserve is open to the public and is also home to the region's largest renewable energy project, the Mohammed Bin Rashid Solar Park. Known for its admirable sustainability initiatives, Al Marmoom Desert Conservation Reserve is abundant with native wildlife. It hosts one of the largest populations of Arabian oryx in Dubai and the highest concentration of large flamingos in the UAE. Enjoying over 40 hectares of shrub land and fertile area, the reserve is home to over 204 species of native birds, 158 species of migratory birds, many other endangered species and over 10sq/km of lakes, encompassing the Al Qudra Lakes.

Additionally, a variety of reptile species can also be found across Al Marmoom's different habitats. The 3,000-year-old Saruq Al Hadid archaeological site, one of the oldest sites in the country dating back to the Iron Age is also located within the reserve, making it a popular cultural and historical attraction.

Oryx, gazelles, camels and birds - the desert is home to a range of natural inhabitants. Once considered globally extinct, the Arabian oryx has successfully been saved after captive breeding programmes and re-introductions in several areas in the UAE, including Al Marmoom.

## **MOHAMMED BIN RASHID AL MAKTUUM SOLAR PARK**

The Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum Solar Park is the largest single-site solar park in the world based on the Independent Power Producer (IPP) model. It has a planned production capacity of 5,000 MW by 2030, with investments totaling AED 50 billion. When completed, it will save over 6.5 million tons of carbon emissions annually.

The Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum Solar Park contributed to DEWA winning the Best Sustainable Project of the Year in the UAE at the 2014 MEED Quality Awards. This is the first time this award was given to a renewable energy project in the Middle East and North Africa.

## **HAMDAN SPORTS COMPLEX**

If you're a sports fan, you'll get a kick out of these all-purpose sports and events facility. Discover a competition arena that seats up to 15,000 people and two high-tech Olympic-standard swimming pools, which are occasionally converted into a competition space for various sports events,

ranging from karate to basketball tournaments. The centre has also hosted badminton, tennis, volleyball, and water polo events to name a few. Located on sight are gym, sauna, and jacuzzi facilities available for both men and women. Adults are welcome in the facility's pools; however, those under the age of 18 must have a swimming club license to swim.

## **MALL OF EMIRATES**

Home to a ski slope, cinema complex and 560 shops and boutiques, a visit to the Mall of the Emirates is a must-see on any trip to Dubai. Shop, dine and stroll beneath the glamorous Fashion Dome.

## **SKI DUBAI**

You can easily recognise it from afar – it's the slanted building perched on top of the mall. ## AL MIRFA BEACH

Al Mirfa Beach is located on the Arabian gulf and it is in the 12th place out of 13 beaches in the Abu Dhabi Emirate region 98.8 km away from its center, the city of Abu Dhabi. It is one of the beaches of Al Mirfa settlement, just 0.7 km from its center. The beach is located in an urban area.

## MIRFA PARK

## SHEIKHA SALAMA BINT BUTTI PARK

Liwa Oasis is about 97.6 km (60.6 mi) south of the Persian Gulf coast and 150 km (93 mi) southwest of the city of Abu Dhabi, on the northern edge of Rub' al Khali desert. It stretches about 100 km (62 mi) east-west, along an arch curved to the north. It consists of some 50 villages.

## **AL DHAFRA CASTLE**

The castle is located in Sayh Al Surra, nearly 30 kilometres east of Madinat Zayed, and is mentioned in old manuscripts related to the region's history.

Apparently the threat was being expected from the south, as the south wall of all the 3 forts has 2 towers. The entrance is always in either the west or east wall.

## AL JAHILI FORT

Al Jahili Fort is one of the UAE's most historic buildings. It was erected in 1891 to defend the city and protect precious palm groves. The former headquarters of the Oman Trucial Scouts, the force that protected the mountain passes and kept inter-tribal peace, it also served as a residence for the local governor. It is set in beautifully landscaped gardens, and visitors are encouraged to explore it.

## AL AIN OASIS

In the heart of the city, the Al Ain Oasis has been opened as the UAE's first curated UNESCO World Heritage site visitor experience. Spread over 1,200 hectares (nearly 3,000 acres) and containing more than 147,000 date palms of up to 100 different varieties, this impressive oasis is filled with palm plantations, many of which are still working farms. The cool, shady walkways transport you from the heat and noise of the city to a tranquil haven; all you will hear is birdsong and the rustle of the palm fronds. The site introduces visitors to the delicate oasis eco-system and the importance it has played in the development of the emirate. The oasis landscape of Al Ain is shaped by a complex shared water supply based on both wells and 'aflaj', the UAE's traditional irrigation system. Al Ain Oasis has plenty of working examples of the falaj which have been used for centuries to tap into underground wells.

## AL AIN PALACE MUSEUM

Located on the western edge of Al Ain Oasis, the Palace of the late Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan was built in 1937. It was converted into a museum in 1998 and opened to the public in 2001. The original structure comprised a private residence for the ruler and his family within a complex of courtyards. The architectural design and construction of Al Ain Palace is typical of historical buildings of the UAE. It features the characteristic ventilation structures that are designed to keep the buildings cool in the



summer. Locally sourced and environmentally friendly building materials were used, including clay, adobe and plaster stones, as well as palm tree elements for roofing rooms, ceilings, doors and windows. The use of teak was later introduced in the renovation of the buildings.

## **SOUQ AL QATTARA**

Dating back to the mid-20th century and founded by the late Sheikh Shakhbut bin Sultan Al Nahyan on the palm-lined road linking Al Ain's Al Qattara and Al Jimi oases, the historic Souq Al Qattara has been renovated and re-opened. A traditional handicrafts market takes place here every Thursday, Friday and Saturday from October to May, encouraging local families to preserve and promote Abu Dhabi's heritage through an active involvement in traditional craft production. The Souq is linked to the redeveloped Al Qattara Fort, now home to a popular arts center, featuring hundreds of modern exhibits, workshops, a café and a library.

## **AL QATTARA ARTS CENTRE**

What was originally the Al Qattara Fort is today the Al Qattara Arts Centre. This traditional mud-brick tower and house is located on a mound overlooking the date-palm gardens of Qattara Oasis, which it was originally built to protect. Showcasing carefully restored traditional local architecture, the centre aims to provide a family-friendly venue where arts and culture can be studied, practiced, and developed by the entire UAE community and visiting travellers.

## **HAZZA BIN ZAYED STADIUM**

The home of Al Ain FC, this 25,000-seat stadium is one of Al Ain's tallest buildings and a recognizable landmark. The outer façade design of this stadium is inspired by a palm tree trunk, an integral part of the UAE's heritage and culture. The stadium is part of a wider project, constructed in phases, which will ultimately include residential, commercial, and entertainment areas, as well as a luxury hotel and sports facilities.

## **UAE UNIVERSITY**

United Arab Emirates University is the oldest university in the United Arab Emirates. It was established in 1976. The UAEU is an accredited research-based institution. Its alumni have provided the United Arab Emirates with ministers, diplomats, senior government officials, and business leaders.

## **SHEIKH KHALIFA BIN ZAYED GRAND MOSQUE**

The Sheikh Khalifa Bin Zayed Grand Mosque, also known as Al Ain Grand Mosque, will be able to accommodate 20,000 worshipers. It is composed

of a basement level and ground floor and will also include a 160-meter-wide dome that will cover the main prayer hall and four 60-metre-tall minarets. The complex will also include other buildings for classrooms and offices, as well as underground parking.

## **AL AIN ZOO**

This 900-hectare park near the base of Jebel Hafeet is where visitors can see a large animal collection in enclosures that closely resemble their natural habitats. There are plenty of green public spaces for picnics and playgrounds, a cafeteria, and a train tour of the wildlife area. The Al Ain Zoo is home to over 4,000 animals, with at least 30% of its 180 species considered endangered. Conservation efforts have been strengthened by partnerships with San Diego Zoo, the Fairchild Tropical Botanical Garden in Miami, and the World Association of Zoos & Aquariums.

## **GREEN MUBAZZARAH**

Strategically located at the feet of the Jebel Hafeet Mountains, Green Mubazzarah is home to a number of spending Chalets that make a great retreat away from the noise of the metropolis providing guests with a deluxe lodging and intimate access to the great outdoors. Green Mubazzarah occupies part of the rocky mountain side and been landscaped with rolling grassy hillsides alongside streams, hot springs and waterfalls. Green Mubazzarah Chalets is less than a 40 minute-drive from Al Ain International Airport and 15 minute-drive from Wadi Adventure.

## **JEBEL HAFEET**

Rising 1,240 meters, Jebel Hafeet is the emirate's highest peak, and the UAE's second. This towering rocky mountain, which stands guard over Al Ain and borders Oman, is forged out of craggy limestone that has been weathered over millions of years. Significant fossil discoveries have been made in the area, which are vital pieces in the jigsaw on the city's ancient history. Over 500 ancient burial tombs dating back 5,000 years have been found in the Jebel Hafeet foothills. Once you reach the top, you'll be rewarded with magnificent views over Al Ain.

## **QASR AL MUWAIJI**

For more than 100 years, this incredible historic fort has played a major role in the history of the United Arab Emirates. The Qasr Al Muwaiji fort was built in the early 20th century to protect and watch over the oasis, and is a great place to take photos today. The simple yet impressive

square enclosure features a grand entrance gate and protruding corner towers. Over the years, Qasr Al Muwaiji has been used as a home for the ruling family, a place for the community to gather, and as a seat of governance.

## **HILI ARCHAEOLOGICAL PARK**

If history fascinates you, then you'll want to add Hili Archaeological Park to your itinerary. Now a modern park where you're able to picnic and go for peaceful walks, this UNESCO World Heritage site dates back to the Bronze Age and includes evidence of settlements dating back to about 2000 BCE, with ancient tombs. Also visit the nearby Hili 8 where, in 1977, French archaeologists began excavating and found the remains of barley, wheat, and date palm as well as bronze objects, pottery, and livestock. 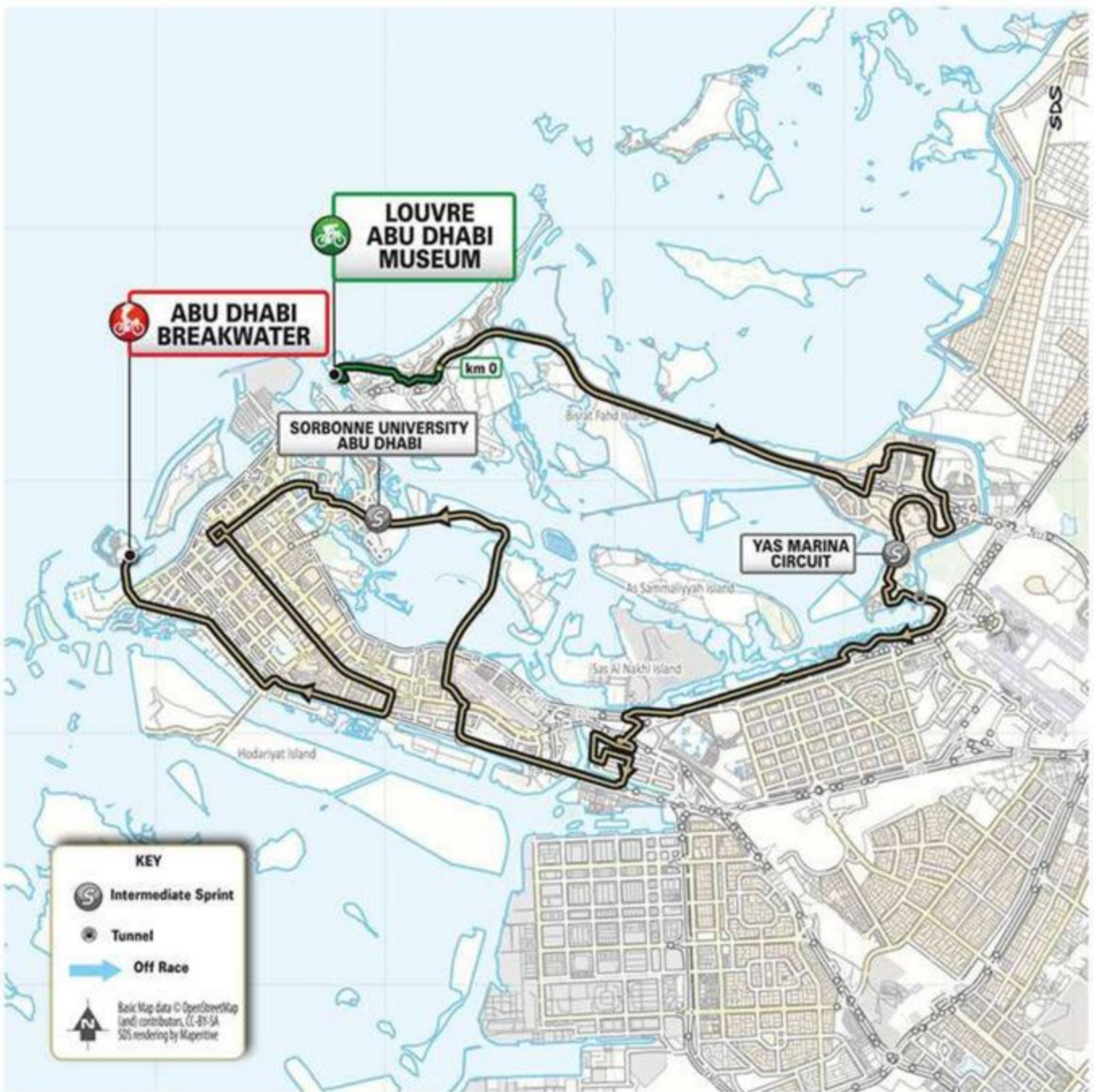

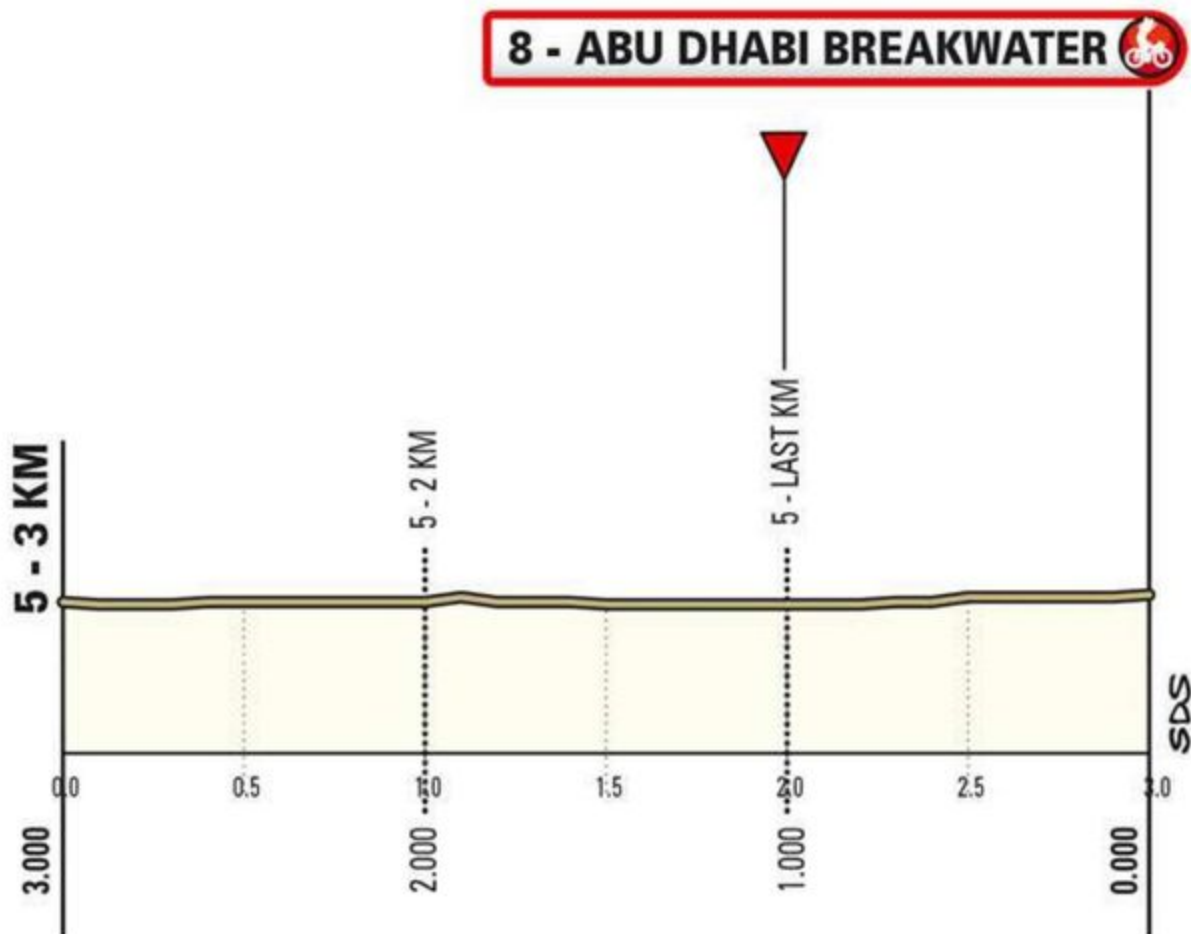

# REGULATIONS

## ART. 1 - ORGANIZATION

ABU DHABI SPORTS COUNCIL and DUBAI SPORTS COUNCILS call and organize, in cooperation with RCS SPORTS AND EVENTS DMCC (Fortune Executive Tower, JLT, Cluster T - P.O. Box: 24883 - Dubai, United Arab Emirates - T. +971 44058800), website [www.theuaetour.com](http://www.theuaetour.com), the UAE TOUR WOMEN an international cycling stage race on the international UCI WOMEN WORLDTOUR calendar (2.WWT), in compliance with the International Cycling Union regulations.

The race will start in Dubai on Thursday 8th February and finish in Abu Dhabi Sunday 11th February 2024 according to the following program:

The technical guide of the UAE tour Women 2024 details each stage, timetables, start and finish sites, distances in kilometres together with the relevant stage routemaps and profiles. The race director, subject to prior notification to the chief commissaire, can change the timetables and/or itineraries, if need be, giving prior notice to the interested parties. (Article 2.2.029) Furthermore, he might summon the representatives for the "Extreme Weather Protocol" in compliance with article 2.2.029 bis. In such a situation, decisions can be taken and/or confirmed on the morning of the stage (See the "Extreme Weather Protocol").



# REGULATIONS

## ART. 2 – TYPE OF RACE

The race is reserved to Women Elite Category and points will be awarded for the “Individual UCI World Ranking” - stage races, according to the provisions set out in Articles 2.10.002 ter and 2.10.008 of the UCI regulations.

## ART. 3 – ENROLLMENT

According to Article 2.1.005 and 2.1.007 bis of the UCI regulations, the race is reserved to: UCI Women’s WorldTeams, UCI women’s continental teams, UCI cyclo-cross professional teams, National Team of the host country. In compliance with Article 2.2.003 of the UCI Regulations, the number of Riders per team shall be 6 (six).

In any case, the Organization, so as to safeguard the image and the reputation of its race, reserves the right to reject, up to the start, the Riders or the Teams which, by their acts or statements, would prove to neglect the principles of sport fair play and the undertaken commitments as set forth in Article 1.1.023 of the UCI regulations. Furthermore, in the event the Riders or the Team should fail during the race in complying with the principles set out in the foregoing paragraph, the Organization shall also reserve the right to expel them from the race at any time, in compliance with the Article 2.2.010 bis

## ART. 4 – GENERAL PROVISIONS

The subjects listed hereunder are liable for the enforcement of the present regulations and – for all that is not regulated under the present ruling – of the current regulations issued by the International Cycling Union:

- the titular race Riders;
- the Sports Directors and the Teams’ staff;
- all the Race’s followers duly accredited by the Organizers in a recognized and acknowledged official position.

Only the persons notified upon getting the identification badge by the owners of the authorized vehicles are entitled to follow the race. Each and every change or addition shall be notified to the Organization Manager. The cars and motorcycles’ drivers shall comply not only with the enforced rules of the Highway Code, but also with the provisions issued by the Organization Manager and his staff. Persons without any function acknowledged by the Organizers or relevant to the race’s services as well as under-aged persons are not allowed to follow the race. In the event of non-compliance about “the circulation during the race” will apply to the articles of the Part



2 Road Races, Chapter 2, paragraph 4, UCI regulations. The Organizing Society shall not be accountable for any damage caused by accidents or incidents before, during and after the race to spectators or people in general, even if not involved in the race itself, because of actions that have not been performed by the Organization itself. For all that is not regulated under the present ruling, the regulations issued by the UCI are enforced.

## ART. 5 - RIGHTS AND DUTIES OF RIDERS

All registered Riders have the right, in compliance with the regulations in force, to compete in all the classifications – i.e. stage classification, general and special classifications – inscribed in the race program.

They are required to maintain a responsible race behavior and to refrain from promoting or supporting any mass demonstration susceptible to assume the character of either fraudulent agreements prejudicing other Competitors, or to appear as a protest against the Organizing Society or the Commissaires' Panel or other official followers whatsoever.

Moreover, the titular Riders are requested:

A) to carry a frame number and two body numbers duly provided by the Organization. These numbers cannot be modified as far as their size is concerned (Articles.1.3.076/077)

B) to carry on all the stages a transponder supplied by the Organization and to be affixed on the frame of the bicycle, for the automatic reading of their passage position on the finish line and in some other segments determined by the Organization. However, the crossing of the finish line will be the final reference for the stage classification.

Failure in complying with such obligation shall be considered as an infringement equivalent to the absence of body number and consequently punished in accordance with UCI Table 2.12.007/3.5.3

C) to wear the jersey corresponding to their relevant team as well as the World Championship or National Championship jerseys; in order of priority in compliance of the Article 1.3.071.

D) the leaders of the General Classification, the Points Classification, the Best Young Rider Classification, the Intermediate Sprints Classification, shall respectively wear the Red jersey, the Green jersey, the White jersey, the Black jersey, all of them duly provided by the Organizing Society. This order also features the priority between the different leader's distinctive jerseys, so that in the case a Rider should be leading more than one classification, he would wear the distinctive jersey having a priority in the above-mentioned order. The remaining jerseys would be put on, at an honorific

title, by the next following Riders in the ranking of the respective classifications, provided that they are not already entitled to a different classification (Article 2.6.018). The jersey-holder is required to wear his distinctive garment beginning from the signature procedure until to the prize-giving ceremony and during any possible press conference;

E) to refrain from answering to interviews during the race.

F) to quickly leave the left side (or right only if safer) of the road free for motorcycles and vehicles authorized to overtake the peloton;

G) in case of drop-out in the course of the race, to remit the body number to a Commissaire or to the "Broom wagon".

H) to refrain – after having crossed the finish line – from crossing the line a second time while still wearing his body number, and thus until the finish judge or the finish Commissaire in charge authorize the crossing (UCI Table 2.12.007/1.6)

I) The General Classification leader and the stage winner shall show up at the press room or the for a press conference with the accredited journalists (Article 2.2.082).

J) to undergo the Anti-Doping procedure, the convened Riders shall go to the premises indicated by the Organizer.

K) to behave appropriately with a respectable behavior in line with the local tradition and regulations, using all the carefulness necessary. For example, riders shall use structures that the organizer will provide like changing rooms and bathrooms in all start and finish areas.

To pay particular attention to the environment while disposing of trash and empty bottles.

## ART. 6 – RACE HEADQUARTERS

The official accreditations and preliminary operations will take place in Abu Dhabi on the premises of Radisson Blu Hotel - YAS Island – YAS Plaza from 10:00 to 18:00 on Wednesday 7th February 2024. The confirmation of the starting Riders and the collection of the race numbers by the Sports Directors is set at the Race Headquarters on 7th February from 16:00 to 16:45, subsequently at 17:00 at the Race Headquarters is due to take place the Meeting with the Organization Management, the Commissaires Panel, the Sports Directors and with the presence of UCI Technical

Delegate, according to the provisions set out in Articles 1.2.087-88/2.2.093 of the UCI regulations. At 10:30 - The Race Director with the President of Commissaires'Panel will hold "Race security briefing" for all Drivers, cars and motorcycles, which will be involved in the race convoy, for a Representative of the television production and for a Representative of the Highway Police, see Article 2.2.034 bis of the UCI regulations.

#### **ART. 7 – PRELIMINARY OPERATIONS AT THE START**

For each stage Riders shall assemble at the place mentioned in the Technical Guide. As far as road race stages are concerned, the presence of the Riders at the Podium where the starting sheet is to be signed is duly requested (Article 2.3.009). Then, Riders will gather for the group transfert towards the actual start place. In addition, for all stages, the Organizer will set the team order for team presentation and to sign the starting sheet. This order list will be communicated the day before with the official communication.

#### **ART. 8 - TOP-RIDERS PHOTOSHOOTING AND TEAM PRESENTATION**

Depending on the Covid situation and the following protocols Organizer may set Top-Riders photoshooting and their press conference, Organization will communicate the list of riders needed a week before. Teams will make available the Top-Riders requested with the support of team press officer. All the Teams, with all their Riders and two Team Managers and/or Sports Directors shall take part in the opening and teams presentation ceremony in case it will be organized.

#### **ART. 9 – RADIO INFORMATION**

Race news will be broadcasted on the frequency VHF 149.850 MHz. Organizers will provide the radio for every car in the race and to all vehicles or person shall need it.

#### **ART. 10 – TIMEKEEPING**

The Timekeepers Service, with the assistance of the finish judge, will be in charge of recording the official time. The service will be guarantee by EMG Italy SpA. Riders will be provided with a trasponder, for the automatic reading of their time, to be affixed on the frame of the bicycle compulsarily.

#### **ART. 11 – TIME BONUSES**

Time Bonus valid for the General Individual Classification are envisaged in each stage except the time trial stage. According to the Article 2.6.019 UCI regulations, the time bonuses will be as follows:

# REGULATIONS

- for each Intermediate sprint the time bonuses for the first three riders crossing the line will be respectively 3", 2" and 1"
- upon finishing each stage respectively 10", 6" and 4" time bonuses will be assigned to the first three riders crossing the line.

## ART. 12 SIGNPOSTS

The Organizing Society shall place the necessary signposts along the race route. For each stage, detailed information about safety and about the road's situation will be provided in the "Daily Race Communiqués", as well as any fixed areas of feeding if any. (Articles 2.2.015/1.2.064)

## ART. 13 – GREEN ZONES

The Green zones will be signposted along the race route and communicated daily on the race official communications on route maps and in the time schedules as well as. Organization is committed to collect all the waste referred to the race and invites all the suiveurs to behave in way respectful of environment safeguard.

## ART. 14 – TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

The technical assistance service is provided for by 3 vehicles of the SHIMANO company.

## ART. 15 – MEDICAL SERVICE

The Medical Service appointed by the Race Manager, is provided by an adequate number of Doctors and Paramedics; the service is operative during the race and available before the start and after the finish of the race. In case of need, following ambulances coordinated by the race Doctors will take the Riders to the hospitals mentioned in the Technical Guide.

## ART. 16 – STAGE FINISHES

Stage finishes shall be announced in advance by a red triangle located one kilometer from the finish line and by an arch in coincidence with the time keeping and photo finish line. It is mandatory for all vehicles to perform a detour from the race route where indicated by the Organizer, in order not to cross the finish line, exception for the Race Management, the Commissaires' Panel and the official Doctor vehicles. In the case of a crash, puncture or mechanical incident beyond the signpost

indicating the finish within three kilometres, the rider(s) affected shall be credited with the time of the group in whose company he was (they were) when the accident occurred, in compliance with Article 2.6.027 of the UCI Regulations. The rule does not apply to stages featuring a summit finish (3rd). For all that is not regulated under this ruling, the irrevocable decision taken by the Commissaires' Panel in consultation with the Organization Management shall apply. The "Protocol for stages expected to finish in bunch sprints" will be enforced in stages 1, 2 and 4 for calculating time gaps.

#### **ART. 17 – FINISHING TIME LIMIT**

In order to determine the finishing time limit, the stages have been divided into three categories depending on the different nature of their route:

- A category: stages presenting no particular difficulty (Stage 1, 2 and 4)
- B category: stages presenting difficulty (Stage 3)

Consequently, the time limit has been set out as follows:

- for the A category the winner's time plus:
  - 16% if the average speed is less than or equal to 37 Km/h.
  - 17% if the average speed is between 37 and 41 Km/h
  - 19% if the average speed is over 41 Km/h
- for the B category the winner's time plus:
  - 22% if the average speed is less than or equal to 34 km/h
  - 23% if the average speed is between 34 and 37 km/h
  - 25% if the average speed is over 37 km/h

According to Article 2.6.032 of the UCI regulations, in case of exceptional circumstances, confirmed accidents or incidents, the Commissaires Panel, after consultation with the Organization Manager, may readmit in the race any Rider finishing in a time exceeding the time limit, by increasing the latter by a maximum of 30% of the time set out in this article. The time limit, established on the basis of the winner's time expressed in minute seconds, shall be further rounded off to the successive superior minute. In case, for those Riders readmitted, all points awarded in the general classification of the various secondary classifications shall be withdrawn.

#### **ART. 19 – PENALTIES**

Infringements will be sanctioned according to UCI Rules and to the "Table of race incidents" (2.12.007).

# REGULATIONS

## ART. 20 – PRIZE-GIVING PROTOCOL

After every stage finish, the stage winner, the leader of the General Classification who receives the red jersey, the leader of the General Classification by Points who receives the green jersey, the leader of the Best Young Rider Classification who receives the white jersey and the leader of the Intermediate Sprints Classification who receives the black jersey shall attend the prize-giving ceremony. After the final stage UCI WWT best rider and UCI WWT best young rider will be awarded as per UCI WWT protocol regulations. Moreover, the stage winner and the leader of the General Classification shall participate in the press conference for the accredited journalists. (Articles 1.2.112/113 and 2.6.018 bis)

## ART. 21 – ANTI-DOPING

Antidoping Control will be made on the dedicated premises by the finish area. The Doping Control Officer (DCO) charged by the ITA and acting on behalf of UCI will enforce the UCI Regulations, in compliance with the ITA's instructions and procedures, in accordance with Chapter 14 of the UCI ADR-TIR (Testing Investigation Rules) and with the relevant Law in force of the hosting country.

## ART. 22 – GENERAL INDIVIDUAL CLASSIFICATION BY TIME

The Leader of the General Individual Classification will wear the Red jersey. In compliance with the provisions set out in Article 2.6.014 of the UCI regulations, the General Individual Classification is established by adding together the times achieved by each rider in each stage. Time bonuses and penalties are considered for this classification. In the event of a tie in the General Individual Classification the first discriminating criteria is given by the hundreds recorded in the individual time trial stage, the second is given by the lower sum of the placing obtained in each stage, as a last resort, the place obtained in the final stage is counted (Article 2.6.015).

## ART. 23 – GENERAL INDIVIDUAL CLASSIFICATION BY POINTS

The Leader of the General Individual Classification will wear the Red jersey. In compliance with the provisions set out in Article 2.6.014 of the UCI regulations, the General Individual Classification is established by adding together the times



At each Intermediate Sprint points are awarded as follows:

1st	8 points
2nd	5 points
3rd	3 points
4th	1 point

At each finish of the seven stages points are awarded as follows:

1st	20 points
2nd	16 points
3rd	12 points
4th	9 points
5th	7 points
6th	5 points
7th	4 points
8th	3 points

According to the provisions set out in Article 2.6.017 of the UCI regulations, in the event of a tie in the General Classification by Points the following criteria will be applied:

1. Number of stage victories
2. Number of Intermediate Sprint victories
3. General Individual Classification

To receive the prizes of the final General Classification Riders will have to complete the Race.

#### **ART. 24 – BEST YOUNG RIDER**

The Best Young Classification is reserved to Riders born after 1st January 2001 and is determined by the General individual Classification. The Leader will wear the White jersey

# REGULATIONS

## ART. 25 – “INTERMEDIATE SPRINT JERSEY” CLASSIFICATION

A special Intermediate Sprint Classification has been set up, at each Intermediate Sprint points are awarded as follows:

1st	8 points
2nd	5 points
3rd	3 points
4rd	1 points

The general ranking is established by the sum of the points obtained; the Leader of the Intermediate Sprint Classification shall wear the Black jersey.

In the event of a tie in the Intermediate Sprint general classification, the following discriminating criteria will be applied:

- Number of Intermediate Sprint victories
- General individual classification

To receive the prizes of the final General Classification Riders will have to complete the Race.

## ART. 26 – TEAM CLASSIFICATION

According to the provisions set out in Article 2.06.016 of the UCI regulations, the team classification is established on the basis of the sum of the three best individual times from each team. In the event of a tie the teams shall be separated by the sum of the places acquired by their three best times in the stage. If the teams are still tied, they shall be separated by the placing of their best rider on the stage classification. The team general classification shall be calculated on the basis of the three best individual times from each team in each stage ridden.

In the event of a tie the following criteria shall be applied in order until the teams are separated:

- Number of first places in the daily team classifications;
- Number of second places in the daily team classifications;
- etc.

If there is still a draw, the teams shall be separated by the placing of their best rider in the general individual classification. Any team reduced to fewer than three riders shall be eliminated from the general team classification.

#### **ART. 27 – RACE MANAGEMENT**

The UAE Tour race will be managed in compliance with the UCI regulations through the UCI Commissaires appointed according to the art. 1.1.070 and in collaboration with the RCS Sports technical race management coordinated by the race director Mauro Vegni (tel. +390225848766).

#### **ART. 28 – REGULAR AND SPECIAL PRIZES**

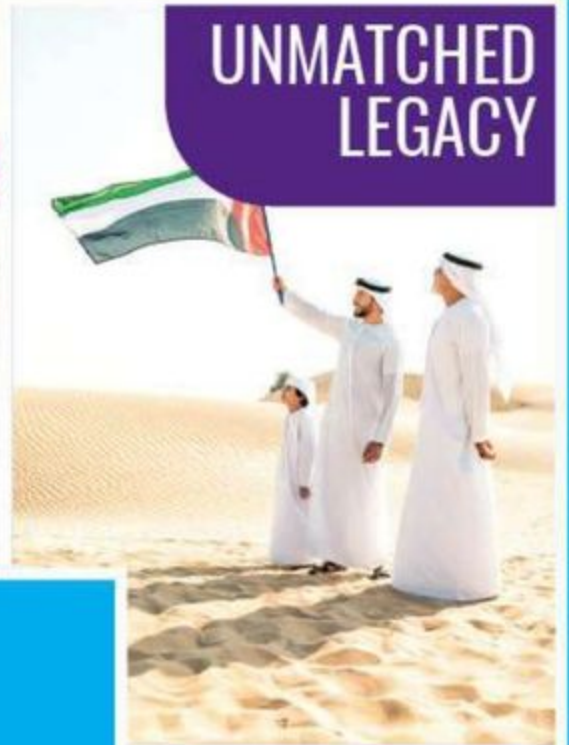
