TABRIZ

Tabriz is the fifth most populated city in Iran, one of the historical capitals of Iran and the present capital of East Azerbaijan Province. It is situated in the valley of Quru River and its elevation from sea level is about 1,350 meters. Tabriz is located in a valley to the north of the long ridge of the volcanic cone of Sahand, south of the Eynali mountain. The valley opens out into a plain that slopes gently down to the north eastern end of Lake Urmia, 60 kilometres (37 miles) to the west. With cold winters and temperate summers the city is considered a summer resort.

The estimated population of the city is around 3,000,000 based on results of the Iranian census bureau. Tabriz is the fifth most populous city in Iran after Tehran, Mashhad, Isfahan, and Karaj. Tabriz is a major hub for heavy industries including automobile, machine tools, oil and petrochemical and cement production.

Many monuments in the city date back to the Ilkhanid, Safavid, and Qajar periods, among them is the large Tabriz Historic Bazaar Complex which is inscribed as a World Heritage Site in 2010. The oldest signs of the civilization in the city is an excavation site and museum in the city center with a history that dates back 2500 years.

Saat Tower

The Municipality was built in 1934 as the Tabriz municipal central office. After World War II it was used by the Azerbaijan Democrat Party as a Government Office. When Iranian troops regained control of Tabriz in 1947, the building was again used as the Tabriz municipal central offices, a function which has continued up to the present day Since Saat Tower is located in the center of the city, it has been used for various ceremonies and gatherings in the city. During 1947 it was used as the seat of the Azerbaijan Peoples' Government.







Start Layout Stage 2\Tabriz, Elgoli Park





LAST 3Km STAGE 1 ROUTE MAP & PROFILE









STAGE 1 FINISH LAYOUT & FINISH TO HOTEL

URMIA

Urmia is a city in and the capital of West Azerbaijan Province, Iran. Urmia is situated at an altitude of 1,330 m above sea level, and is located along the Shahar Chay river (City River) on the Urmia Plain. Lake Urmia lies to the east of the city, with the mountainous Turkish border to the west.

Urmia is the 10th most populated city in Iran. At the 2012 census, its population was 1,265,721 with 700,000 households. The city's inhabitants are predominantly Azeris, who live alongside minorities of Kurds, Assyrian Christians and Armenians.

The city is the trade center for a fertile agricultural region where fruit (especially apple and grape) and tobacco are grown. An important town by the 9th century, Urmia was seized by the Seljuk Turks (1184), and later occupied a number of times by the Ottoman Turks.

Lake Urmia is a salt lake in northwestern Iran near Iran's border with Turkey. The lake is between the Eastern Azerbaijan and Western Azerbaijan, west of the southern portion of the similarly shaped Caspian Sea. It is the largest lake in the Middle East and the sixth largest saltwater lake on earth with a surface area of approximately 5,200 km² (2,000 mile²), 140 km (87 mi) length, 55 km (34 mi) width, and 16 m (52 ft) depth.[3]

Lake Urmia along with its approximately 102 islands are protected as a national park by the Iranian Department of Environment.





Benis:

"Village of the Firsts" or "Luxury Village" is the name given to the village of Benis in East Azerbaijan; A village located 60 km northwest of Tabriz and 3 km north of Shabstar city. This village is one of the most unique and beautiful villages in the country, which is located on the southern slopes of the Misho mountains and is surrounded by green and beautiful gardens that are irrigated by aqueducts and waterfalls from the mountains, and in 1996, it was named a global healthy village by the organization UNICEF has been introduced globally.

"Benis" is neither illiterate nor unemployed; The only rural university in the country has been built and equipped in this village with the participation of the residents, and a production unit (factory) has been set up where most of the residents of the village are working.

Benis city is surrounded by nearby mountains, which supply a stream that feeds into a local aqueduct. The aqueduct waters local gardens and greenery. There is a mosque, public bath, and various shops located around the village square. A main asphalt road leads south out of the village, into the rest of Shabestar County.

During the summer, the population of Benis increases significantly. Agriculture has been a local industry in Benis for many years, and continues to grow. In the 19th century, most migrations from the village were to foreign cities such as Istanbul, Baku and Tbilisi. After the Russian Revolution, more immigration took place from Benis across the country and into cities such as Abadan, Ahvaz and Tehran. Many workers are chiefly active in the businesses of confectionery production, and the processing of paper.








STAGE 3 HOTEL TO START & START LAYOUT







STAGE 3 ROUTE MAP & PROFILE






ELGOLI - TABRIZ

El-Gölü is the name of a large park in Tabriz, Iran. It has an square artificial lake surrounded by side walk in four sides. There is also a building in the middle of the lake, with traditional architecture of Tabriz. In South of the lake there is a hill covered by trees. Two beautiful stairways connecting the side walks to the top of the hill. At top of the hill there is a building with modern architecture (Hotel Pars building). There is also a small luna park next to the park.


History

Early history of the El-Gölü is not clear. However, it seems that the lake originally was used as a water resource for agricultural purposes. At old times there was an artificial island with an small palace in the middle of the lake which was used as royal summer palace during the Qajar dynasty (when Tabriz was the official residence of Prince of Iran). During 2nd Pahlavi's the palace was reconstructed and a pass-way is built to connect the island to the side walks around the lake.

Etymology

After the Iranian Revolution of 1979 as normal process for that period for removing Shah name from everywhere the name of Shah-Gölü was changed to El-Gölü in official documents meaning People's Lake.

RTICLE 6. RACE INCIDENTS OCCURRING IN THE LAST 3 KILOMETERS

In the case of duly noted fall, puncture, or mechanical problem after passing the sign of the last 3 km, in a road race stage, the rider¬(s) involved shall be credited with the time of the rider¬(s) in whose company they were riding at the moment of the necident. His or their placing shall be determined by the order in which he or they ctually crosses the finishing line. If the rider(s) are unable to cross the finish line they will be placed last on the stage and credited with the time of the rider(s) in whose company they were riding at the time of the incident. (UCI 2.6.027). The above will ot apply on certain stages where the finish is at the top of a hill climb, The Race Jury will decide the qualification of "at the top" or "before a hill climb" (UCI 2.6.029). This

ARTICLE 7. FEEDING

Food and drinks may be taken from team vehicles after 30 km from the actual start each day and up to 20 km before the finish behind the car of the Commissaires or as otherwise indicated by Commissaires. If the group consists of 15 or fewer riders, food and drinks may be supplied at the rear of that group. If the weather is too hot the Commissaires will adjust these distances appropriately by announcement before the stage start.

A Feeding zone will be marked in stages in excess of 150 km. It will be marked by a sign "BUFFET" at the commencement of the zone and a further sign "BUFFET END" at the conclusion. All feeding must be from the right side of the road, on foot, and by team personnel only. The route schedule will state where these feeding zones will be located. Riders may not, without due care, jettison food, bonk-bags, feeding bottles, clothes, etc. in any place whatsoever except as below. Riders may not jettison anything on the roadway itself but shall draw to the side of the road and safely deposit the object there. Suitable deposit zones will be marked along the road.

ARTICLE 8. FINISHING TIME LIMITS

Taking into account the characteristics of each stage, the finishing time limits vary according to the application of the following of coefficients:

Coefficient 1

Stages with no particular difficulty (Stage I and V). The time limit is calculated according to the actual time recorded by the winner plus: 10%.

Coefficient 2

Stages with rolling terrain (Stage II). The time limit is calculated according to the actual time recorded by the winner plus:

15%.

Coefficient 3

Stages with Very rolling terrain (Stages III, IV). The time limit is calculated according to the actual time recorded by the winner plus: 20%.

Possible reinstatement

The Commissaire's Jury may in exceptional cases allow one or several particularly unlucky riders to be reinstated in the race, after informing the race directors. In this

UCI anti-doping test regulations are applicable to the event. Moreover, and in conformity with the law of IR IRAN, Iranian anti-doping legislation is applicable in addition. The anti-doping Control will be signposted from the Finishing line of each stage. Riders required for this Control will be listed on a notice close to the finish line and at the Control venue. Riders required for doping control will be notified by chaperones.

ARTICLE 13- PENALTIES

he UCI penalty scale is the only one applicable.

Article 14-¬Organisation

The Committee of Organisation has appointed personnel who are qualified and esponsible for the organization of the race (Race Direction). They will take all neasures necessary to assure the regularity and security of the race and the liscipline and control of all participants.

- The racing will be controlled by the Colleague of Commissaires (Race Jury) under the lirection of the President Commissaire appointed by Union Cycliste Internationale. All persons in their different duties within the organization of the race, also the puests of the race, are considered to be officials of the race during the period of the race.
- The Race Organisation will arrange for a medical service, which will include three nedical teams, fully equipped. The organization will also arrange for a "broom" ehicle to take abandoned riders for the remainder of that stage, as well as a vehicle o transport luggage between stages.
- he Race Organisation will provide all accredited personnel with accommodation nd meals from Breakfast on 27 September until Breakfast on 04 October 2022; or arlier departure, unless otherwise agreed before the race start.
- all vehicles in convoy must comply with the regulations of UCI with a maximum reight of 1.66 meters and be marked with sponsor and team signs, which the organization will provide. They may not have obscured windows. All participants in our of Iran (Azarbaijan) 2022, whether riders or officials, will be covered for health and third-party insurance by the organization.

Article 15-¬Teams

he Organizer will also arrange for three (3) "neutral" technical service vehicles and a

motorcycle (1) service to travel with the race and will be available to service all riders during the race. Any equipment accepted from these "neutral" service vehicles must be returned or refunded at the end of the stage.

Article 16 - Teams

The Team DS (Directeurs Sportifs) represent their teams and are responsible for all their activity from a technical point of view and also for their discipline. The team DS will collaborate with the Race Organization and the Colleague of Commissaires to ensure the smooth running of the race.

Team vehicles which travel with the race will be driven in convoy order determined by the classification of their leading rider in the general classification, apart from stage one when the order will be determined by the drawing of lots at the meeting referred to in Article 4 and conforming to the regulations of UCI. All other vehicles - especially Media vehicles - will be driven according to the instructions of the Colleague of Commissaires or the Race Organisation (See Article 14 above).

Where a team has a second vehicle this **MUST** depart from the start area at least 20 minutes before the race start time. Team second vehicles will proceed in convoy either to the feeding zone or direct to the finish. This second vehicle is not permitted to travel in the race cavalcade with the other team vehicles. If it proceeds to a "feeding zone", then after "feeding" it must follow after the last race vehicle (Broom vehicle) and is NOT permitted to pass the race unless with special instruction from the Commissaries.

All vehicles will be driven in accordance with the traffic laws of The Islamic Republic of IRAN.

Any vehicle traveling ahead of the race which wishes to wait for any riders must park off the roadway, unless more than 15 minutes ahead.

Article 17 - Conduct of riders and their responsibilities

Conduct of riders and their responsibilities Riders must sign on,

themselves, before every stage start at the signing on point which will be open from 60 minutes until 10 minutes before the start time. It is requested that a team signs on all its' members as a complete team – not separately. Riders must behave in a sporting fashion during the race and at all other times. Riders must wear the numbers issued to them by the race organization. These numbers must not be folded, cut, or defaced in any way and must be worn clearly visible. 1 Riders must wear their official team jerseys, as approved at the meeting when licenses were registered, or else the Leader Jersey for the various classifications. Riders must always wear rigid

afety headgear (UCI 1.3.031) when racing. Rain capes' design must be transparent or be similar to the jersey by use of one of the principal team colors. The team's name must be displayed on it. The riders' race numbers must be clearly visible. Riders must omply with all traffic rules and the instructions of police or race officials and ride so is to keep the left-hand side of the road clear to allow the passing of race vehicles. Aiders may only exchange equipment, wheels, or bicycles with members of their own team. They may only assist riders who have suffered an accident, puncture, or other mechanical trouble who are members of their own team.

tiders may exchange food or drink with members of their own or other teams. Riders hay not push another rider or be pushed or receive a tow or a pull by another rider or other person. They may not take pace or receive or take a push or tow from any ehicle. Public nuisance, by rider or official, such as dropping of litter or urination public, will be penalized by either a fine or a time penalty, as appropriate (UCI 2.1.040 - 29). Toilets will be available, 1 adjacent to and signposted from each start and finish. Neutral service will be provided by three neutral service vehicles and one neutral motorcycle.

Article 18-¬Race Distances

The separate schedule in the race technical manual shows the details and distances of each stage and marks any mountain sprints (BC) or intermediate sprints (PC). Distances during stages will be marked:

tages

a sign "0 km" will be displayed at the real start point. All times and distances are alculated from this point. The race will not stop at this point for the "real start" to be taken.

There will be a sign at 30 km from the real start and then signs at distances to go to he finish: 25 km; 20 km; 15km; 10 km; 5 km; 4 km; 3 km; 2 km. The "one kilometer to the finish" point will be marked by a red triangle flag and also a sign stating "1 km". Thereafter, distances will be marked at 500 m; 300 m; 200 m; 150 m 100 m and 50 m.

Article 19-¬Race Regulations

The Race Organisation and Colleague of Commissaries reserve the right to change these regulations should special circumstances apply and as they may decide. They will ensure that any such changes are announced in a Bulletin.

All persons by taking part in the race, whether as riders, officials or in any other capacity, confirm that they accept and agree to abide by these regulations.

ARTICLE 20- PROTECT THE GREEN ENVIRONMENT

We will appreciate all personnel on the race paying attention to hygiene and public health.

Waste zones will be established at any designated feeding area and 20 km before the finish of each stage, Riders must safely and exclusively deposit their waste on the sides of the road in this area

ARTICLE 21- APPROVED

These Regulations have been approved by the Cycling Federation of IR IRAN.
