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## Article 1 - Organisation

The 17th Tour du Rwanda is organized by the Rwanda Cycling Federation (FERWACY), chaired by Mr. Samson NDAYISHIMYE, its President. The event, which takes place under the organization and direction of its Managing Director Mr. Freddy KAMUZINZI, is governed by the regulations of the International Cycling Union (UCI). It will take place from February 23 to March 2, 2025 and shall include one prologue and seven stages.

## Article 2 - Type of event

The event is reserved for riders of Elite Men's and Under-23 Men's categories. It is part of the UCI Africa Tour calendar.

The event is registered as ME 2.1

As per UCI regulation, following points will be awarded for the UCI world classification :

- 125 - 85 - 70 - 60 - 50 - 40 - 35 - 30 - 25 - 20 - 15 - 10 - 5 - 5 - 5 and 3 points from 16th to 25th riders of the final general classification.
- 14 - 5 - 3 points to the first 3 riders of each stage, from the 2nd stage.
- 3 points to the leader of the general individual ranking at the end of each stage from the 2nd stage.

## Article 3 - Participation

In accordance with article 2.1.005 of the UCI regulations, the event is open to UCI World Teams (50%), UCI Pro Teams, UCI continental teams, UCI professional cyclocross teams, national teams.

By UCI derogation, the event is also open to mixed teams, as defined in article 2.1.004 of the UCI regulations.

The number of riders per teams is fixed at 5.

In accordance with article 2.2.003 bis of the UCI regulations, a team is not allowed to start with less than 4 riders.

## Article 4 - Race headquarters

The race headquarters is located at the KIGALI DELIGHT HOTEL, 24 KG 414 Street, [www.kigalidelighthotels.com](http://www.kigalidelighthotels.com) and will be open on Saturday 22 February from 9.00am to 5.00pm.

The confirmation of starters and the collection of race numbers by team managers will take place on Saturday 22 February, from 9.00am to 11.30am at the race headquarters.

The team managers' meeting, with the members of the Commissaires' panel, will take place on Saturday 22 February, at 11.45am at the race headquarters.

## Article 5 - Radio-Tour

Race information will be broadcast on "Radio-Tour" on 157,575 MHz frequency.

### Article 6 - Neutral Technical Support

The neutral support service is provided by the organization with two cars and one motorbike.

## Article 7 - Feed zones

The organizer will set up feed zones in accordance with the new provisions of the UCI regulations (art.2.3.025).

Every 30 to 40 km, the organizer will set up a feed zone next to a waste zone.

Refreshments along the course (by foot) will only be carried out in the zones reserved and indicated by the organizer, by the accompanying staff, a member of the team holding a UCI licence to the exclusion of any other person. Refreshment staff must wear team clothing so that they can be identified and must stand no more than one metre from the edge of the road.

## Article 8 - Provisions for the prologue

### The prologue will take place as follows:

- Individual Time Trial
- 4 km urban circuit. Start/Finish : Amahoro Stadium
- Starts will be given in 1' intervals.
- The start times will be communicated to the teams on Saturday 22 February.
- For logistical reasons, only road bikes will be allowed. Time trial bikes are not permitted.
- From the start of the first rider, training is prohibited on the course.
- A rider who has an accident during the prologue and is unable to finish the race may start the following day. He will be credited with the last time.

## Article 9 - Arrangements

for stage finishes Arrival times Depending on the specificity of each stage, the finishing deadlines are set as follows :

Prologue	Kigali Amahoro stadium	
1st stage	Rukomo - Kayonza	15%
2nd stage	Kigali - Musanze	20%
3rd stage	Musanze - Rubavu	20%

5th stage	Rusizi - Huye	20%
6th stage	Nyanza - Kigali Canal Olympia	20%
7th stage	Kigali - Kigali	20%

In accordance with article 2.6.032 of the UCI regulations, the Commissaires' panel may extend finishing deadlines after consultation with the organizer.

## Incident within the last 3 kilometers

Finishes of the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th stages are not considered as summit finishes. Provisions of article 2.6.027 of UCI regulations will apply on these stages (incident within last 3 kilometers).

6th and 7th stages are considered as summit finishes.

## Article 10 - General individual time classification

The general individual time classification is calculated by adding together the times recorded for each rider in prologue and stages, taking penalties into account.

In accordance with article 2.6.015 where two or more riders make the same time in the general individual time classification, the fractions of a second from the individual time trial shall be added back into the total time to decide the placings. If the riders are still tied the placings obtained in each stage shall be added and, as a last resort, the place obtained in the last stage ridden shall be taken into consideration.

The leader of the general individual time classification shall wear the yellow jersey presented by "**Visit Rwanda**".

### This jersey is worn while racing.

## Article 11 - Intermediate Sprints classification

A general ranking of Intermediate Sprints is established by adding the points obtained to each intermediate sprints in each of the 7 road-race stages, according to the following scale :

- In each intermediate sprint, from 1st to 3rd classified rider : 8 - 6 - 4 points

In case of equality of points, the following criteria are applied until the riders are separated :

1. number of wins in intermediate sprints.
2. general individual classification by time.

To be eligible to the prize money relating to the Intermediate Sprints classification, riders must ride the entire distance of the event within the finishing deadlines.

The leader of the intermediate sprint classification shall wear the "Total energies" jersey.

### This jersey is worn while racing.

## Article 12 - Overall Best Climber's classification

An overall Best Climber's classification is calculated by adding together the points obtained at the summit of the climbs which count towards the classification, according to the following scale :

- 1st Category : 11 - 8 - 6 - 4 point(s), from 1st to 4th rider ;
- 2nd Category : 8 - 6 - 4 point(s), from 1s to 3rd rider ;
- 3rd category : 4 - 3 - 2 point(s), from 1st to 3rd rider ;

As per article 2.6.017, in the event of a tie, the following criteria shall be applied in order until the riders are separated :

1. number of first places in the highest category climb ;

2. number of first places on climbs in the next inferior category and so on ;  
3. general individual classification by time.

To be eligible to the prize money relating to the overall Best Climber's classification, riders must ride the entire distance of the event within the finishing deadlines.

The leader of the overall Best Climber's classification wears the white and blue « Forzza » jersey.

#### **The jersey is worn while racing.**

#### **Article 13 - Best Young rider's classification**

The Best Young rider's classification is reserved for the riders born in 2004 or after. The first of them in the general individual time classification is leader of the individual classification of the young riders.

The leader of the Best Young rider's classification shall wear the "Prime Insurance" jersey.

#### **The jersey is worn while racing.**

#### **Article 14 - Overall individual classification for Rwandan riders**

The overall individual classification for Rwandan riders (from all teams) is awarded to the first Rwandan rider in the overall individual time classification. On finishing the final stage, he will be declared winner of the overall individual classification for Rwandan riders.

The leader of overall individual classification for Rwandan riders shall wear the "Centrika" jersey.

#### **The jersey is worn while racing.**

#### **Article 15 - Overall individual classification for African riders**

The overall individual classification for African riders (from all teams) is awarded to the first African rider in the overall individual time classification. On finishing the final stage, he will be declared winner of the overall individual classification for African riders.

The leader of overall individual classification for African riders receives a "Rwandair" jersey on the podium. This jersey is not worn during the race.

#### **Article 16 - Overall individual classification for Young African riders**

The overall individual classification of the Young African riders (from all teams) is awarded to the first African rider in the overall individual time classification born in 2004 or after. On finishing the final stage, he will be declared winner of the overall individual classification of the Young African riders.

The leader of overall individual classification of the Young African riders receives a "MTN MoMo" jersey on the podium.

This jersey is not worn during the race.

#### **Article 17 - Longest breakaway**

During the 7 road race stages, the rider with the longest breakaway of the day receive the prize for the longest breakaway.

The daily winner of the prize for the longest breakaway receive on the podium a "Ingufu GIN" jersey. This jersey is not worn during the race.

#### **Article 18 - Classification by teams**

##### **Classification by teams of the stage**

As per article 2.6.016 of the UCI regulations, the classification by teams of the stage is calculated by adding the three best individual times of riders of each team at prologue and at each stage.

In case of a tie, the teams shall be separated by the sum of the places obtained by their three best riders of the stage. If the teams are still tied, they shall be separated by the placing of their best rider in the stage classification.

The best team of the day will take part in the daily awards ceremony. The riders will wear the "Inyange" jersey during the official ceremony. This jersey is not worn during the race.

##### **General classification by teams**

The general team classification is established by adding the three best individual times of each team in prologue and all the stages. In the event of a tie, the following criteria are applied until the tie is broken :

1. number of first places in the daily team classification,
2. number of second places in the daily team classification,
3. etc.

If there is still a tie, the teams shall be separated by the placing of their best rider in the general individual classification.

Any team with less than three riders is eliminated from the classification by teams of the stage and from the general classification by teams.

#### **Article 19 - Fight against doping**

Each team agrees to scrupulously respect the regulations and procedures relating to the fight against doping. Team shall be entirely responsible for the strict adherence to these regulations by the riders, teams staff and providers.

Anti-doping tests will be conducted under the authority for the International Testing Agency (ITA) and designated officials at the finish of each stage, in the premises designated for this purpose, in the host-town.

#### **Article 20 - Protocol ceremony**

By derogation to article 2.6.018 of the UCI regulations, six leaders' jerseys will be worn during the race.

At the end of the prologue, the following riders must attend the protocol ceremony :

- The winner of the prologue (Visit Rwanda jersey, worn during the race on the 1st stage). As an honorary gesture, the winner of the prologue will also receive the distinctive jersey Ingufu GIN (Longest breakaway), not worn during the race,
- The rider ranked 2nd in the prologue (Amstel jersey, worn during the race on the 1st stage),
- The rider ranked 3rd in the prologue (Forzza jersey, worn during the race on the 1st stage),
- The rider ranked 4th in the prologue (TotalEnergies, worn during the race on the 1st stage),
- The leader of the best young rider classification (Prime Insurance jersey, worn during the race),
- The rider ranked "best African" in the general individual classification by time (Rwandair jersey, for ceremonial purposes only),
- The rider ranked "best Rwandan" in the general individual classification by time (Centrika jersey, worn during the race),
- The rider classified as the "best young African" in the general individual classification (MTN MoMo jersey, for ceremonial purposes only),
- The riders of the team classified as the "best team" of the stage (Inyange jersey, for ceremonial purposes only).

At the end of each stage, the following riders must attend the protocol ceremony :

- The stage winner (Amstel jersey, worn during the race on the following stage)
- The leader of the general individual classification by time (Visit Rwanda jersey, worn during the race)
- The leader of the best climber classification (Forzza jersey, worn during the race)
- The leader of the best young rider classification (Prime Insurance jersey, worn during the race)
- The leader of the intermediate sprints classification (TotalEnergies jersey, worn during the race)
- The rider ranked "best African" in the general individual classification by time (Rwandair jersey, for ceremonial purposes only)
- The rider ranked "best Rwandan" in the general individual classification by time (Centrika jersey, worn during the race)
- The rider classified as the "best young African" in the general individual classification (MTN MoMo jersey, for ceremonial purposes only)
- The winning rider in "L'Echappée du Jour" (Ingufu Gin jersey, for ceremonial purposes only)
- The riders of the team classified as the "best team" of the stage (Inyange jersey, for ceremonial purposes only).

At the end of each stage, the following riders must attend the protocol ceremony :

- The stage winner (Amstel jersey, worn during the race on the following stage)
- The leader of the general individual classification by time (Visit Rwanda jersey, worn during the race)
- The leader of the best climber classification (Forzza jersey, worn during the race)
- The leader of the best young rider classification (Prime Insurance jersey, worn during the race)
- The leader of the intermediate sprints classification (TotalEnergies jersey, worn during the race)
- The rider ranked "best African" in the general individual classification by time (Rwandair jersey, for ceremonial purposes only)

- The rider ranked "best Rwandan" in the general individual classification by time (Centrika jersey, **worn during the race**)

- The rider classified as the "best young African" in the general individual classification (MTN MoMo jersey, for ceremonial purposes only)

- The winning rider in "L'Echappée du Jour" (Ingufo Gin jersey, for ceremonial purposes only)

- The riders of the team classified as the "best team" of the stage (Inyange jersey, for ceremonial purposes only)

At the finish of the final stage in **Kigali**, the following riders will have to present themselves for the final protocol :

- The stage winner (Amstel jersey)

- The top 3 in the general individual time classification

- The leader of the overall individual time classification (Visit Rwanda jersey)

- The leader of the best climber classification (Forzza jersey)

- The leader of the best young rider classification (Prime Insurance jersey)

- The leader of the intermediate sprints classification (TotalEnergies jersey)

- The rider ranked "best African" in the general individual time classification (Rwandair jersey)

- The rider classified as the "best young African" in the general individual classification (MTN MoMo jersey)

- The rider ranked "best Rwandan" in the general individual time classification (Centrika jersey)

- The winner of the prize of the longest breakaway of the stage (Ingufo Gin jersey)

- The riders of the team classified as the "best team" of the stage (Inyange jersey)

- The riders of the team that won the overall team classification at the Tour du Rwanda (Inyange jersey)

#### **Article 21 - Penalties**

Penalties apply exclusively in accordance with the UCI rules.

#### **Article 22 - Environment**

The organizer has set up litter collection zones. Riders may only dispose of their waste and any other objects in these zones; however, riders are permitted to offer their water bottles to spectators on the climbs in the last 50 kilometers of the stage, ensuring that the disposal of their water bottle does not present any danger to either the spectators or the riders.

Riders and followers must adopt responsible behavior with regards to the environment. In accordance with article 2.12.007, disposing of waste or other objects outside of litter zones is punished as follows:

1st infringement CHF 250 fine and 15 points from the UCI rankings; 2nd infringement CHF 500 fine, 30 points from the UCI rankings and 1 minute penalty; 3rd infringement CHF 1 000 fine, 50 points from the UCI rankings and disqualification.

#### **Article 23 - Objection - Exclusion**

Ferwacy considers the preservation of its image, its reputation and that of its event of the utmost consequence.

Ferwacy expressly reserves the right to refuse participation in - or to exclude from - the event, any team or members of a team, whose presence shall seriously blemish the image and/or reputation of the event.

Furthermore, Ferwacy may exclude from the event any team or any of its members in the following cases :

- a breach of the event's rules, including those concerning the event's internal rules (e.g. the rules concerning accommodation);
- a serious breach of Rwandan law;
- acts of vandalism committed in the race or outside the race;
- indecent attire or inappropriate behavior;
- any other act or deed which is liable to damage the image and/or the reputation of the event.

#### **Article 24 - Image rights**

In order to enable the wider broadcasting and promotion of the Tour du Rwanda, each team, and therefore each rider within the teams, acknowledges that participation in the competition grants the organizer and its beneficiaries or legal representatives to reproduce and display, without any compensation whatsoever, his name, voice, picture, biography and more generally his sports performance within the framework of the Tour du Rwanda as well as the brand(s) of his equipment manufacturers and sponsors, in any form and on any material existing or in future, in any format, for any communication in the public domain throughout the world, for any purpose including promotional and/or commercial use without any limitations, and for the duration of the protection currently given to any territory by the laws or regulations, judicial decisions and /or arbitration of any country, and international conventions either existing or in the future, including any extensions that may be made to this duration.

However, when the organizer authorizes third parties to use pictures of the event for advertising or promotional purposes, it will not allow the latter to use the name, voice, image, biography or performance sports of a rider or team nor the brand of their sponsors or equipment with a view to a direct or an indirect association between the rider, the brand of his sponsors or equipment manufacturer and the product, the service, the brand or trade name of the said third party, without the express permission of the rider, sponsor or supplier concerned. Similarly, with the exception of books, photo books, comics, any form of publishing, video cassettes, CD-ROMs, DVDs or more generally any video recordings or video on any medium and format whatsoever, that may become the

subject, in whole part of the Tour du Rwanda, posters, bills, log books, autograph books, maps and official program for the Tour du Rwanda, the organiser will not use and will not allow the utilization of the individual image of a rider within the framework of the marketing of tie-in merchandising.

#### **Article 25 - Language**

The present regulations are written in French which language shall prevail in the event of difficulty in interpreting its terms in another language.

Le classement général individuel des jeunes coureurs Africains (quelle que soit son équipe) récompense le premier d'entre eux, nés en 2004 ou après, au classement général individuel au temps. A l'issue de la dernière étape, il est déclaré vainqueur du classement général individuel des jeunes coureurs Africains.

Le leader du classement du classement général individuel des jeunes coureurs Africains reçoit, sur le podium protocolaire, un maillot « MTN MoMo ». Ce maillot n'est pas porté en course.

#### Article 17 – Lauréat de l'Echappée du Jour

Lors des 7 étapes en ligne, le coureur réalisant la plus longue échappée de l'étape du jour, sera honoré à l'arrivée de l'étape et recevra, sur le podium protocolaire, un maillot « Ingufu Gin ». Ce maillot n'est pas porté en course.

#### Article 18 - Classement par équipes

##### Classement par équipe du jour

Conformément à l'article 2.6.016 du règlement UCI, un classement par équipes du jour est établi par l'addition des trois meilleurs temps individuels des coureurs de chaque équipe à l'issue du prologue et de chaque étape.

En cas d'égalité, les équipes sont départagées par l'addition des places obtenues par leurs trois premiers coureurs du prologue ou de l'étape. En cas de nouvelle égalité, les équipes sont départagées par la place de leur meilleur coureur au classement du prologue ou de l'étape.

La meilleure équipe du jour se présentera à la cérémonie protocolaire quotidienne. Les coureurs porteront le maillot « Inyange » lors de la cérémonie protocolaire. Ce maillot n'est pas porté en course.

##### Classement général par équipes

Le classement général par équipes est établi par l'addition des trois meilleurs temps individuels de chaque équipe au prologue et dans toutes les étapes.

En cas d'égalité, il est fait application des critères suivants, jusqu'à ce qu'il y ait départage :

1. Nombre de premières places dans les classements par équipes du jour ;
2. Nombre de deuxièmes places dans les classements par équipes du jour,
3. etc.

S'il y a toujours égalité, les équipes sont départagées par la place de leur meilleur coureur au classement général individuel.

Toute équipe réduite à moins de trois coureurs est éliminée du classement par équipes de l'étape et du classement général par équipes.

#### Article 19 - Lutte contre le dopage

Les équipes participantes s'engagent à appliquer les règlements et procédures en matière de lutte contre le dopage et sont pleinement responsables de leur parfait respect par leurs coureurs et plus généralement par tous leurs salariés et prestataires.

Le contrôle antidopage s'effectue sous l'autorité de l'International Testing Agency (ITA) par les officiels désignés, à l'arrivée de chaque étape, dans le local réservé à cet usage, dans la ville-arrivée.

#### Article 20 - Protocole

Par dérogation à l'article 2.6.018 du règlement UCI, six maillots de leaders seront portés en course.

À l'issue du prologue, doivent se présenter au protocole :

- Le vainqueur du prologue (maillot Visit Rwanda, porté en course sur la 1ère étape) ; à titre honorifique, le vainqueur du prologue recevra également le maillot distinctif Ingufu Gin (l'Echappée du jour), non porté en course
- Le deuxième du prologue (maillot Amstel, porté en course sur la 1ère étape)
- Le troisième du prologue (maillot Forzza, porté en course sur la 1ère étape)
- Le quatrième du prologue (maillot TotalEnergies, **porté en course sur la 1ère étape**)

- Le leader du classement du meilleur jeune (maillot Prime Insurance, porté en course)
- Le coureur classé « meilleur Africain » au classement général individuel au temps (maillot Rwandair, uniquement protocolaire)
- Le coureur classé « meilleur jeune Africain » au classement général individuel au temps (maillot MTN MoMo, uniquement protocolaire)
- Le coureur classé « meilleur Rwandais » au classement général individuel au temps (maillot Centrika, porté en course)
- Les coureurs de l'équipe classée « meilleure équipe » du prologue (maillot Inyange, uniquement protocolaire)

À l'arrivée de chaque étape, doivent se présenter au protocole :

- Le vainqueur de l'étape (maillot Amstel, porté en course sur l'étape suivante)
- Le leader du classement général individuel au temps (maillot Visit Rwanda, porté en course)
- Le leader du classement du meilleur grimpeur (maillot Forzza, porté en course)
- Le leader du classement du meilleur jeune (maillot Prime Insurance, porté en course)
- Le leader du classement des sprints intermédiaires (maillot TotalEnergies, **porté en course**)
- Le coureur classé « meilleur Africain » au classement général individuel au temps (maillot Rwandair, uniquement protocolaire)
- Le coureur classé « meilleur jeune Africain » au classement général individuel au temps (maillot MTN MoMo, uniquement protocolaire)
- Le coureur classé « meilleur Rwandais » au classement général individuel au temps (maillot Centrika, porté en course)
- Le coureur lauréat de « L'Echappée du Jour » (maillot Ingufu Gin, uniquement protocolaire)
- Les coureurs de l'équipe classée « meilleure équipe » de l'étape (maillot Inyange, uniquement protocolaire)

À l'arrivée de la dernière étape à Kigali les coureurs suivants devront de présenter au protocole final :

- Le vainqueur de l'étape (maillot Amstel)
- Les 3 premiers du classement général individuel au temps ;
- Le leader du classement général individuel au temps (maillot Visit Rwanda)
- Le leader du classement du meilleur grimpeur (maillot Forzza)
- Le leader du classement du meilleur jeune (maillot Prime Insurance)
- Le leader du classement des sprints intermédiaires (maillot TotalEnergies)
- Le coureur classé « meilleur Africain » au classement général individuel au temps (maillot Rwandair)
- Le coureur classé « meilleur jeune Africain » au classement général individuel au temps (maillot MTN Momo)
- Le coureur classé « meilleur Rwandais » au classement général individuel au temps (maillot Centrika)
- Le coureur lauréat de « L'Echappée du Jour » (maillot Inguru Gin)
- Les coureurs de l'équipe classée « meilleure équipe » de l'étape (maillot Inyange)
- Les coureurs de l'équipe lauréate du classement général par équipes du Tour du Rwanda (maillot Inyange)

#### **Article 21 - Pénalités**

Le barème des sanctions du Règlement UCI est le seul applicable.

#### **Article 22 - Environnement**

L'organisateur met en place des zones de collecte des déchets. Les coureurs ne peuvent jeter leurs déchets et tout autre objet que dans ces zones ; les coureurs sont toutefois autorisés à offrir leurs bidons aux spectateurs uniquement dans les ascensions situées dans les 50 derniers kilomètres de l'étape en s'assurant que le jet de leur bidon ne présente aucun danger ni pour les spectateurs, ni pour les coureurs.

Les coureurs et les suiveurs doivent adopter en toutes circonstances un comportement responsable vis-à-vis de l'environnement.

Conformément à l'article 2.12.007, le jet de déchets en dehors des zones définies est sanctionné comme suit : 1ère infraction amende de 250 CHF et 15 points aux classements UCI ; 2ème infraction amende de 500 CHF, 30 points aux classements UCI et pénalité de 1 minute ; 3ème infraction amende de 1 000 CHF, 50 points aux classements UCI et mise hors compétition.

#### **Article 23 - Récusation - Exclusion**

La FERWACY tient pour essentielle la préservation de son image, de sa réputation et de celle de l'épreuve.

La FERWACY se réserve expressément la faculté de refuser la participation à - ou d'exclure de - l'épreuve, une équipe ou l'un de ses membres, dont la présence serait de nature à porter atteinte à l'image et/ou à la réputation de l'épreuve.

En outre, la FERWACY pourra récuser ou exclure de l'épreuve une équipe ou l'un de ses membres dans l'un des cas suivants :

- Infraction aux règles de l'épreuve, y compris celles concernant la discipline interne à l'épreuve (règles concernant l'hébergement par exemple)
- Infraction grave à la loi rwandaise
- Acte de vandalisme perpétré en course ou hors course
- Tenue indécente ou comportement inconvenant
- Tout autre acte ou fait qui serait de nature à porter atteinte à l'image et/ou à la réputation de l'épreuve

#### **Article 24 - Droit à l'image**

Afin de permettre la diffusion et la promotion du Tour du Rwanda la plus large possible, chaque équipe, et en conséquence chacun des coureurs qui le composent, reconnaît que sa participation à l'épreuve autorise l'organisateur et ses ayants-droits ou ayants-cause à reproduire et à représenter, sans rémunération d'aucune sorte, ses nom, voix, image, biographie et plus généralement sa prestation sportive dans le cadre du Tour du Rwanda de même que la/les marque(s) de ses équipementiers et sponsors, sous toute forme, sur tout support existant ou à venir, en tout format, pour toute communication au public dans le monde entier, pour tout usage y compris à des fins publicitaires et/ou commerciales sans aucune limitation autre que celles visées ci-après, et pour toute la durée de la protection actuellement accordée à ces exploitations par les dispositions législatives ou réglementaires, les décisions judiciaires et/ou arbitrales de tout pays ainsi que les conventions internationales actuelles ou futures, y compris pour les prolongations éventuelles qui pourraient être apportées à cette durée.

Cependant, l'organisateur, lorsqu'il autorisera un tiers à utiliser des images de l'épreuve à des fins publicitaires ou promotionnelles, n'autorisera pas ce tiers à utiliser le nom, la voix, l'image, la biographie ou la prestation sportive d'un coureur non plus que la marque de son sponsor ou équipementier en vue d'une association directe ou indirecte entre ce coureur, la marque de son sponsor ou équipementier et le produit, le service, la marque ou le nom commercial dudit tiers sans l'autorisation expresse du coureur, sponsor ou équipementier concerné.

De même, à l'exception des livres, livres photos, B.D., sous toute forme d'édition, des vidéo cassettes, CD-ROM, DVD ou plus généralement de tous vidéogrammes ou vidéodisques, sur quelque support et format que ce soit dont le sujet porte en tout ou partie sur le Tour du Rwanda, des posters, affiches, carnets de route, carnets de signatures, cartes, programmes officiels relatifs au Tour du Rwanda, l'organisateur n'exploitera pas et n'autorisera pas l'exploitation de l'image individuelle d'un coureur dans le cadre de la commercialisation de produits dérivés dits de marchandisage.

#### **Article 25 - Langue**

Le présent règlement a été rédigé en langue française qui fera foi en cas de difficulté d'interprétation de ses termes dans une autre langue.

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
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
