

Women's cycling has experienced remarkable growth in recent years, a trend that is also reflected in Extremadura, which in 2026 will celebrate the fourth edition of the Vuelta Ciclista a Extremadura Female.


This international competition aims not only to promote this sport in our region, but also to encourage the practice of sports among women and position Extremadura as a benchmark in the

commitment to gender equality. This goal is further highlighted as, once again, the conclusion of the race coincides with the celebration of International Women's Day.

The race will take place from March 6 to 8 and will be classified as a UCI 2.1 event, allowing the participation of international teams and top-level professional riders, up to a total of 15 teams.

Without a doubt, it is a unique opportunity to showcase the strengths of our region and give visibility to the effort and talent of many national athletes, who will have the chance to compete alongside some of the best cyclists in the world.

In addition, our landscape will once again take center stage in a course divided into three stages, designed to test the riders' skills both in the mountains and on the flat. More than 250 kilometers will cross Extremadura from south to north, confirming the unifying character and enormous potential of this competition.




STAGE 1: HERRERA DEL DUQUE - PELOCHE - HERRERA DEL DUQUE (CRI)

Individual time trial out and back to Pelоче, with the technical challenge of riding on the left-hand lane and navigating the final roundabout around Herrera before the finish. A fast course, ideal for time trial specialists. The strongest riders on the flats will aim to create significant gaps from day one. This stage will be key to setting the first general classification and forcing the rest of the field to race offensively in the following stages.



STAGE 2: PUEBLONUEVO DEL GUADIANA - FUENTE DEL MAESTRE

A long and mostly flat stage, designed for a probable mass sprint finish. The main attractions will be the three special sprints (La Albuera, Valverde de Leganés, and La Fábrica), which will enliven the intermediate competition. Before the final loop, there will be a 3rd-category climb in Fuente del Maestre that could stretch the peloton. A day suited for sprinters, but with accumulated fatigue that may take its toll.



STAGE 3: JERTE - JARAIZ DE LA VERA

Decisive day with over 2,500 m of positive elevation and a sequence of major climbs. Highlights include Alto de Piornal (HC) and the double ascent of the demanding Alto de la Desespera (1), which will shape the race. Perfect terrain for climbers and long-range attacks after the intermediate passage through the finish. This stage will decide the general classification of the 2026 Vuelta a Extremadura Femenina.

INDIVIDUAL GENERAL CLASIFICACION

The individual general classification by times is determined by the sum of the times recorded by each rider in the stages, taking into account time bonuses and penalties.



GENERAL REGULARITY CLASIFICACION

The general classification for consistency is obtained by the sum of points recorded in the individual classifications of each stage, according to the following points scale, and taking into account point penalties.



GENERAL MOUNTAIN CLASIFICACION

It will be determined by the sum of the points earned by each rider in the designated climbs, with the rider who earns the most points being the highest classified.



GENERAL SPECIAL SPRINTS CLASIFICACION

It will be determined by the sum of the points earned by each rider at the designated locations, with the rider who earns the most points being the highest classified.



U-23 BEST RIDER CLASSIFICATION

Jersey for the best-placed U-23 rider in the General Individual Classification. Only riders in this category will be eligible for this award.



BEST RIDER FROM EXTREMADURA CLASSIFICATION

Jersey for the best-placed rider from Extremadura in the General Individual Classification. Only riders with a federative license from the Extremadura region will be eligible for this award.



CLASSIFICATION FOR THE COMBATIVITY OF THE STAGE

Jersey for the most combative rider, voted on Social Media (Instagram) during the stage. This jersey will not be worn the following day at the start.



STAGE WINNER

Prize for the rider who crosses the finish line in first position.

TEAM CLASSIFICATION

The prize is obtained by the sum of the three best individual times of each team in all the stages contested, with the best classification going to the team that has totaled the least time. It will be awarded on the last stage.




PROFILE LAST 3 KMS



INTRODUCTION

The Vuelta a Extremadura project consists of an International Stage Race (2.1. WE class) in which riders from the U23, Elite and UCI elite Women's categories will participate. There will be 15 teams of 7 riders and technical staff.

Article 1. ORGANIZATION.

The race "Vuelta Ciclista a Extremadura Femenina- 2026" is organised by the Extremadura Cycling Federation, Fundación Jóvenes y Deportes and the General Directorate of Sports of the

Extremadura Regional Government. It is held under the regulations of the Royal Spanish Cycling Federation and UCI.

This Tour is registered in the calendar of the Royal Spanish Cycling Federation and UCI and will be celebrated from 6 to 8 March 2026.

The race will run among the next towns and kilometers which are detailed below:

Artículo 2. TIPO DE PRUEBA.

The UCI 2.1 race is reserved for riders in the Women Elite and Women U23 categories. The points are awarded according to UCI regulations:

The first 3 riders of each stage will be assigned 14, 5, and 3 points, and 3 points

Article 3. PARTICIPATION

The race is open for riders in Women Elite and the Women U23. At the same time this event belongs to the UCI 2.1 WE class and points are awarded according to UCI regulations. It is open by invitation from the organizer to UCI Women's World Teams (min 1, max 7), UCI Women's ProTeams, UCI women's continental teams, UCI professional cyclo-cross teams, national teams, and regional and club teams. Each team will consist of 7 riders, and teams with fewer than 5 riders will not be allowed to start.

Article 4. PERMANENT OFFICE

Security meeting

According to article 2.2.034 bis of the UCI Regulations, a security meeting will take place on March 5th with the different security agents at 12:00 at Palacio de la Cultura de Herrera del Duque, Calle Feria 59.

The permanent office on March 7 and 8 will be in the organization's bus.

Article 5. TIME TRIAL

The start order will be determined by the organizer in accordance with the commissary panel. Each team will decide the order in which their riders will start (Article 2.6023).

According to Article 2.4.010 of the UCI Regulations, riders must present their bikes for inspection no later than 10 minutes before their start time.

Starts will be given every minute, and the last 10 riders will start every 2 minutes. However, the Commissary Panel may modify this order to prevent two riders from the same team from starting consecutive and for the 1st stage (ITT), the use of a specific bike is allowed.

Article 6. RADIO TOUR AND RACE CARS

The race information will be broadcast from the car of the President of the College of Commissaires on frequency **163.475 MHz**.

Article 7. NEUTRAL TECHNICAL SUPPORT

The neutral technical assistance service is provided by **SPORTPUBLIC 2005, SL**. The service is provided by three vehicles and a broom car.

Article 8. RACE INCIDENTS IN THE LAST THREE KILOMETERS

In the case of a fall, puncture or mechanical incident duly noted, in the last three kilometres during a line stage, the rider(s) injured will be credited with the time of the rider(s) with whom she (they) was (were) traveling at the time of the accident. Their classification will be based on the moment they cross the finish line.

If, as a consequence of a fall duly noted in the last three kilometers, a rider is unable to cross the finish line, she will be classified in the last place on the stage and classified with the time of the rider(s) with whom she was traveling at the time of the accident.

However, pursuant to article 2.6.027 of the UCI regulations, the above provisions do not apply to the following stages:

Stage 1: CRI Herrera del Duque - Herrera del Duque.

Article 9. FINISHING DEADLINES

Depending on the characteristics of the stages, the closing control will be applied in this way:

- 1ª Stage: 40%
- 2ª Stage: 15%
- 3ª Stage: 20%

Pursuant to article 2.6.032 of the UCI regulations, only in exceptional, unforeseeable and force majeure cases, the Commissaires College may extend the control closures after consultation with the organizer.



Article 10. OVERALL INDIVIDUAL TIME CLASSIFICATIONS

The classifications established are:

GENERAL INDIVIDUAL TIME CLASSIFICATION



The General Individual Time Classification is determined by the sum of each rider's stage times, taking into account time bonuses and penalties. In the case of a tie in the General Classification, the hundredths of the individual time trial will be considered. If there were another tie, it would be broken by the sum of the places obtained in each completed stage and, finally, by the place obtained in the last stage.

REGULARITY GENERAL CLASSIFICATION



The Regularity General Classification is obtained by the sum of points achieved in the individual classifications of each completed stage, according to the following scale, and taking into account point penalties.

The rider with the highest score will be the best classified. If there were a tie between one or more riders, it would be resolved in favour of the rider who has obtained the highest number of first places. If the tie persists, the rider with the best position in the Individual General Classification will be favored.

BONUSES

There will be six bonuses distributed as follows:

In **Stage 2** (Pueblonuevo del Guadiana – Fuente del Maestre), bonuses will be awarded at the following Special Sprints: La Albuera Sprint at km 25.7, La Fábrica Sprint at km 59.4, and at the Finish at km 132.8.

In **Stage 3** (Jerte – Jaraíz de la Vera), PM El Piornal at km 50.9, PM La Desesperá (2nd passage) at km 121.10, and at the Finish in Jaraíz de la Vera at km 139.4.

According to Article 2.6.019 of the UCI Regulations, bonuses will be allowed under the following conditions:

BONUSES:

Special Sprints: 3”-2”-1”.

Stage finish: 10”-6”-4”.

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION OF THE MOUNTAIN



It will be determined by the sum of the points obtained by each rider in the scoring highs, being better classified as the one who has obtained more points. In the case of a tie, it will be resolved in favour of the one who has obtained the highest number of first places in the highest category, and then the highest number of first places in the next category, and so on. If the tie persists, it will be broken in favour of the best classified in the Individual General Classification. In the 2026 Vuelta a Extremadura Femenina, we have third, second, first-category, and HC climbs.

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION OF THE SPECIAL SPRINTS



It will be determined by the sum of the points earned by each rider at the designated locations, with the highest-ranked rider being the one who has scored the most points. In the event of a tie, it will be resolved in favor of the rider with the greater number of first-place finishes.

If the tie persists, it will be decided in favor of the rider with the higher position in the Individual General Classification by Time.

GENERAL BEST UNDER-23 CLASSIFICATION



Jersey for the best placed SUB-23 rider in the Individual General Classification. Only riders of this category will be eligible for this prize. The Individual General Classification is established by the sum of each rider’s stage times, taking into account time bonuses and penalties. In the case of a tie in the General Classification, the sum of the places obtained in each stage will be taken into account and, finally, the position obtained in the last stage.

GENERAL BEST EXTREMADURA FEMALE RIDER CLASSIFICATION



Jersey for the Extremadura Female Rider best placed in the Individual General Classification. This prize will only be awarded to riders with a federal license from the Extremadura Region. The Individual General Classification will be determined by each rider’s stage times, taking into account time bonuses and penalties.

In the case of a tie in the Individual General Classification, the sum of positions obtained in each stage will be taken into account and, finally, the position obtained in the last stage.

STAGE COMBATIVITY CLASSIFICATION



Jersey for the most combative rider, voted on Social Media (Instagram) during the stage. This jersey is just a podium jersey, will not be worn the following day at the start.

GENERAL TEAM CLASSIFICATION

It is calculated as the sum of the time spent by the teams at each stage, with the best team being the one with the shortest total time. In the case of a tie, it will be resolved in favour of the team with the highest number of first places in the daily team classification. If the tie persists, the team that has obtained the highest number of second places in the daily team classification, etc., will be favoured. If there were still a tie, the teams would be decided by the classification of their best rider in the Overall Individual Classification.

The Team Classification is made up of the times of the three best riders of each team. If any team has less than 3 riders, they will be disqualified from the General Team Classification.

Article 10.1 PRIORITY IN THE WEARING OF DIFFERENT MAILLOTS

The riders who are in first place in the different general classifications must wear the leader's distinctive jersey during the stages, and they may display their team's advertising as per the regulations. If a rider holds the lead in two or more classifications, she will only be allowed to wear one jersey, according to the priority of the classifications (individual general > points classification > mountain classification > special sprints > under-23 > best Extremadura rider). In this case, during the stage, the rider(s) following in the respective classifications will wear the corresponding leader's jersey.

After the ITT, the awarding of the different jerseys will be as follows:

- **1st place in the ITT:** will wear the Yellow Jersey.
- **2nd place:** will wear the Points Jersey.
- **3rd place:** will wear the Mountain Jersey.
- **4th place:** will wear the Special Sprint Jersey.
- **5th place:** will wear the Most Combative Rider Jersey
- **Best Under-23 rider:** will wear the White Jersey for the best Under-23 rider.

Article 12. PENALTIES.

The UCI scale of penalties is the only one applicable.

Article 13. ANTI- DOPING.

The anti-doping regulations of the UCI and the RFEC apply in full to this race.

The antidoping control will take place on:

- **March 7th** at Paseo de Extremadura (Bus stop). Fuente del Maestre.

Article 14. PROTOCOL.

TEAM PRESENTATION:

The order of team cars will be determined based on the individual time trial classification held in the first stage.

The order of team vehicles will also determine the order of teams for the signing-in control and team presentation in all stages (complete teams)

ON MARCH 7 IN PUEBLONUEVO DEL GUADIANA, THE SIGNING-IN CONTROL WILL OPEN DURING THE TEAM PRESENTATION, WHICH WILL BE REPEATED IN ALL STAGES.

The schedule for the team presentations at the different stages will be as follows:

- **Friday, March 6, 2026.** There will be no team presentation on this stage.
- **Saturday, March 7, 2026.** From 11:45 to 12:30. In reverse order of the team classification, except for the team of the individual general classification leader, which will be presented last.
- **Sunday, March 8, 2026.** From 09:00 to 09:45. In reverse order of the team classification, except for the team of the individual general classification leader, which will be presented last.

At the end of each stage, in accordance with articles 1.2.112 - 1.2.113 of the UCI regulations, the following riders must present themselves on the podium in competition clothing for the protocol ceremony:

Before the start of each stage, the wearers of the leader's jerseys must be at the front of the line for the start protocol.

Likewise, at the end of the last stage, the following riders must also present themselves:

- 3 first classified riders of the Individual General Classification of the Tour of Extremadura Women's Race.
- 1st of the Overall Team Classification.
- The leaders of the following classifications:
 - Regularity
 - Mountain
 - Special Sprint
 - U23
 - Extremeña
 - Aggressiveness (Will not be worn during the race)

Article 15. FEEDING ZONE AND WASTE ZONE

The Fexc provides riders with feeding zones and waste collection zones every 30-40 km. They are marked on the route maps.

Article 16.

All cases not provided for in these Regulations shall be resolved by the UCI Cycling Sport Regulations.
